STERLING AREA RIDING STORM

State of reserves with worst of recession over



THE February movement in the gold and dollar reserves shows that the sterling area is beginning to be affected by the recession in the United States.

No firm conclusions can be drawn from a study of gold movements in any one month, but taken in conjunction with recent performance, the February return underlines the deterioration that has taken place in that part of the reserves which reflects, for the most part, the deterioration of the area's trading balance with North America.

Excessing gold received in part settlement of the area's surplus with the European Payments Union in January and receipts of American defence aid, the genuine gold and dollar surplus for February was only \$2,000,000 (£774,000).

This compares with a genuine surplus of \$3,000,000 in January, 1933, and of \$10,000,000 in the fourth quarter, and \$10,000,000 in the third quarter of 1933. In February, last year, the reddish balance was \$7,000,000.

SLOW RISE

In the six months since July, 1933, official data for the United States declined by eight per cent, it is each, exporting and importing, therefore, that the sterling area has not had any more surplus in the last six months. In fact, the sterling area is running a deficit of \$100,000,000 in the first six months of last year — the first deficit since the outbreak of the war.

There is reason to believe, however, that the reserves will soon recover. 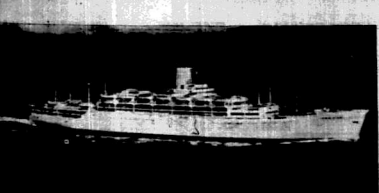

American President refutes depression report

Fighters to carry atom weapons

STRONG OPPOSITION TO MORE TAX CONCESSIONS

PRESIDENT EISENHOWER told Americans in a broadcast that there was no depression and the Government would make sure "we do not have one. He was appealing for support for his tax programme which, he said, would strengthen the economy, create more jobs and give added security to the American worker.

He urged Congress to accept his programme of overall reductions which he limited to a total of \$400,000,000.

He sharply opposed suggestions for further tax concessions. The Government's proposals for further tax increases would "increase savings on taxes would seriously weaken national defence."

"Fleeting his gloom?"

Mr. Eisenhower said that he could not see any real danger to members of the Democratic Party to Congress for its inaction in personal income tax arguments from \$274 to \$285.

"There was no justification for arguments that the nation was on the brink of disaster or that the situation called for further tax cuts to increase the purchasing power of the people," he said in the signing of an executive order.

Mind unchanged?

"The truth is, we do not have a depression. And what is more, as I have said, time and time again, your Government will continue to use all powers available to make sure that we do not have one," he said.

"I am confident that the conditions without serious economic trouble," he said, "has happened time to time to ensure that we would be able to go through any such conditions without serious economic trouble."

Election year

His Administration had already got its work to the end of this fiscal year, and he said that the Budget, as conceived by the Truman Administration, was being considered.

Mr. Eisenhower said that he was confident that the nation was in a state of "prosperity and progress."

Supersonic missile

He said the programme, which provided for the rapid introduction of new missiles, was "designed to improve our state of preparedness over an extended period of time."

"Our progress will continue in the development of our supersonic missiles," he said.

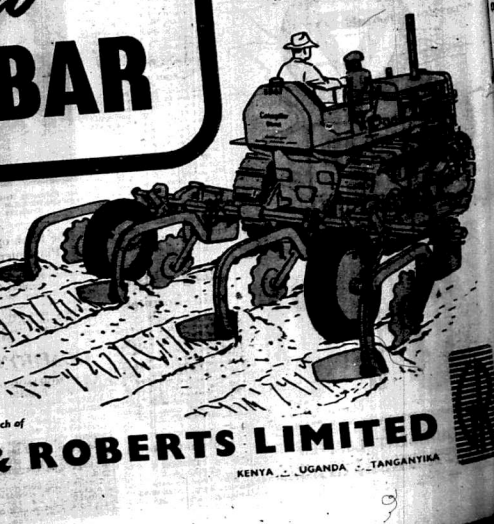

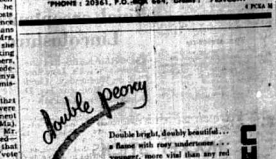

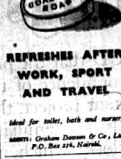
