### New Shell refinery for Australia

#### GEELONG INSTALLATION

The largest refinery in Australia was opened at Geelong on Thursday by the Governor-General, Field Marshal Sir William Slim. The installation, which cost £2,110,000,000, was built by Shell and has a capacity of 1,750,000 tons a year.

The crude oil to be refined at Geelong will be shipped from the Middle East and the Sera crude of British Borneo, both virtually 100 per cent sweetening sources of supply.

The refinery, which is about five miles to the north of the city on the shores of Corio Bay, Geelong Harbour Trust is building a half-mile long jetty to accommodate 1,800,000 g.w. tons—the general tonnage of the refinery, which Shell is building a fleet of 52.

**Underground pipe**

In addition to the crude distillation unit, auxiliary equipment consists of an electric power station, pump stations and an ethyl-blowing plant.

There are more than 20 storage tanks at present in the refinery, some for receiving crude oil and others for various process products. The overall capacity of the tank farms is over 200,000 tons. The capacity is to be doubled in 1955.

Products leaving the refinery will travel either by sea or by road, or via a 36-inch long eight-inch diameter underground pipeline costing £250,000 which will be laid to the company's main installation at Newport, a suburb of Melbourne.

The refinery will pump both petrol and diesel oil through the pipe, with automatic safety and pressure control.

A catalytic cracking unit with a capacity of 800,000 tons a year is to be added to the refinery and will be completed about the middle of next year.

# TANGANYIKA COMPLETES BORDER SWEEP FOR KIKUYU

TANGANYIKA'S Kikuyu border sweep has been extended over the western border where the isolated Kikuyu in the Same district of Tanganyika were being held by the Kenya Border District and Kenya.

# Speed urged for Nairobi sewer plan

THE Works and Finance Committee of Nairobi City Council will meet in the next few days to consider a letter from the Nairobi Ratepayers' Association calling for greater speed in the implementation of the city's sewerage scheme.

The demands will be considered by the Council on March 30. The Council was ready to go ahead with the sewerage scheme in the Parklands-Westlands area of the city, but it is now being held up by the Council. Mr. C. Bamford, secretary of the Ratepayers' Association, said that members disagreed with the present plan of erecting small pieces of the problem and only trying to solve the problem on the emergency basis.

### 15 years work

The opinions and proposals put to the Council for their consideration were:—The 1947 master plan estimated a cost of £5,000,000, including disposal works, for a sewerage system for all of Nairobi. Allowing for increases in wages and materials, this Association believes the present-day cost would be approximately £7,500,000.

The 1953 expenditure on sewers was £136,000 and the last complete sewerage sum of £772,000 spread over five years from 1947 to 1952. On this, the Association believes the present-day cost would be approximately £1,200,000 a year, which is still under discussion.

### Relief loan

IN the light of a £2 million Association urges Council to take immediate steps to raise a loan of £750,000 spread over 15 years, to avert the school of Nairobi.

The Association recommends that the entire cost of the sewerage plant should be a capital charge on public funds.

When the scheme is in progress, it is suggested that a small general increase for water would take the place of the present extra sewerage charge.

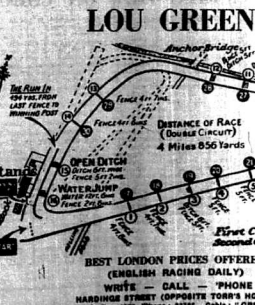

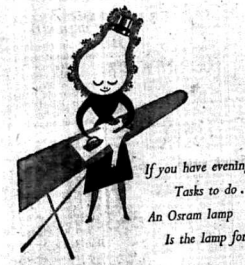

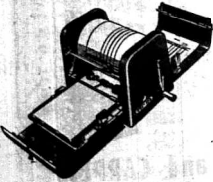
