## NEW ORDER FOR FIREARMS

### Identity cards necessary

PERSONS required by law to have blue identity cards which do not possess them will not be granted firearms certificates when the re-licensing of weapons in the colony starts on April 1. An official announcement yesterday stated that among restrictions to be imposed will be the limitation of pistols and revolvers to one person in most cases and, unless they can prove the need for arms, those living in hotels, clubs and well-populated buildings will not be issued with licences.

## Baganda reject reform offer

### LUKIKO AWAITS VISIT BY COLONIAL EXPERT

THE offer by the Governor of Uganda, Sir Andrew Cohen, to implement the Baganda reforms, which were agreed jointly more than a year ago, providing additional responsibilities for health, agriculture and education for the Baganda Government, has been turned down by the Baganda Lukiko.

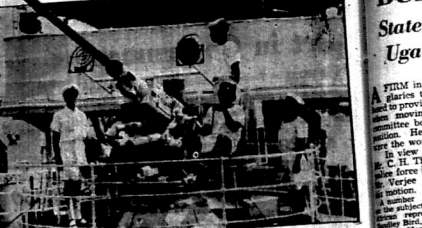

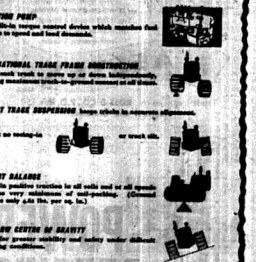

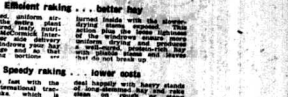

# Kenya's Traffic Ordinance TAXI-CABS

SENIOR SUPERINTENDENT R. W. HOYLE, Kenya's Traffic Chief, clears up current confusion over what is and what is not a taxi-cab.

FOR many years there has been considerable confusion as to the definition of a taxi-cab which was contained in the Traffic Ordinance of 1953. It stated that a taxi-cab was a public service vehicle which was, carrying passengers for hire or reward and which could operate as a vehicle in the town or in the local area.

Unfortunately the definition of a taxi-cab under the old Ordinance made it almost impossible to stop the pirate taxi and to detect vehicles which were being used as taxis without the necessary licences. There were many public service vehicles which were not licensed as taxis but which were used as taxis without the necessary licences.

When the new Ordinance was drafted, a rather wider view was taken of the whole question of taxi-cabs. There is a class of vehicle called Public Service Vehicles which includes those which are let out for hire or reward and those which are let out for hire or reward. This class can be divided into three categories: taxis, motor cabs, and private hire vehicles.

The difference between a taxi-cab and a private hire vehicle is that the taxi-cab is licensed to carry passengers for hire or reward in the town or in the local area. A private hire vehicle is licensed to carry passengers for hire or reward elsewhere.

**REGRET** that the African Members of the Legislative Council had not accepted Mr. Lytton's constitutional proposals as a group was expressed by the Member for Mount Kenya, Group Capt. I. B. Briggs, when he addressed a meeting of Europeans at Nanyuki Sports Club.

Mr. Briggs, who had accepted the proposals, he said, they would have achieved a notable advance.

The meeting, over which Mr. Michael Foster, Member for the Central District, presided, adopted two resolutions. The first, moved by Mr. Briggs, expressed the confidence of his constituents in Group Capt. Briggs and endorsed his attitude during the negotiations with Mr. Lytton.

The second—passed without dissent—deplored the majority decision of the European Members in accepting the proposals of Mr. Lytton.

**Conditions met**  
Group Capt. Briggs said: "When speaking at Nanyuki, I was told that I believed that the final proposals had been finalised without dissent. In the event, my constituents have not accepted the final document and without their assent the submission even to an advisory committee."

"In these circumstances, I view against acceptance but would like to see the proposals which I did at Nanyuki, which would be a notable advance. There was no variation in the proposals made by the Secretary of State and that, in the event of my constituents' proposals, the method of nomination from outside the Legislative Council would not be retained as that would upset the balance between the representatives of the African and European Members of the Council and would be a disadvantage to the African Members."

"These two people have had and, as far as I am concerned, our duty to make the new constitution to be put into effect as soon as possible and to be a step towards the country's progress and expansion and to give liberty to a new spirit of co-operation in the country."

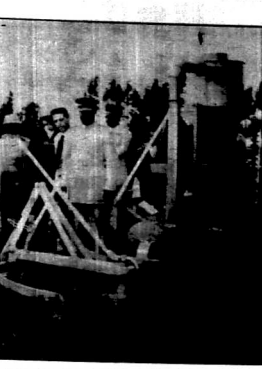
