

All that was wanted was for the first course next month.

Asian girls will not be properly looked after until the nursing staff has been increased to 100, who know their language, Mr. Anderson declared.

Mr. A. H. Bunting, Chairman of the Indian Rehabilitation Trust, said that in the coming year the new wing of the Asian Hospital would be completed for an up-to-date hospital.



To the Editor, "E.A.S. Standard". Many personnel have been recruited from the medical profession, and the provision of valuable resources has been greatly appreciated by the Forces. For myself, as for the Army, the training has been excellent, and I am now fully equipped to accompany the Forces to Abyssinia.
