Plane packed with troops on leave

AMERICAN Air Force officials yesterday were inquiring into how a crash C-124 Globemaster transport plane crashed at Lamon Field, Missouri, Washington State on Saturday killing 87 of the 132 servicemen aboard, many of the passengers were hitch-hiking home for Christmas leave.

The disaster, the worst in the history of aviation since only a few moments after the plane took off, the aircraft plunging into the ground about two miles from the runway and bursting into flames immediately.

The world's biggest air disaster previously was in South Wales when 83 of the 82 people were killed on March 12, 1949, in a transport plane carrying football fans home after a game in Ireland.

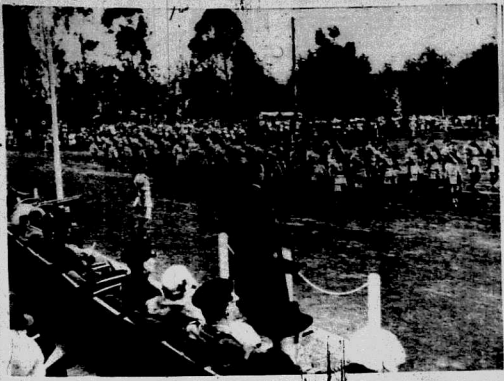

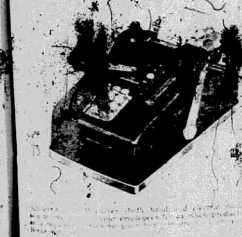

4. A decision by the Government that in the foreseeable future it cannot allow independent below in the Kikuyu areas.

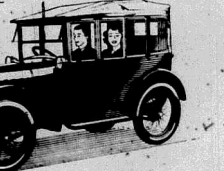
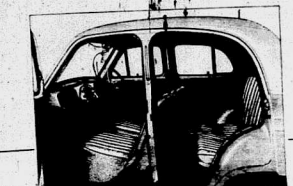

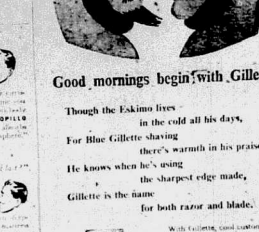
