THE PRESENT OUTBREAK OF FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE

Foot-and-mouth disease is a highly infectious virus disease affecting mainly cattle, pigs and sheep. Humans, being in contact with the disease may develop a sore throat. The disease is very easily spread by direct contact with infected animals, but may also be spread by contact with contaminated objects.

This article is the text of a broadcast made by Dr. PIERCY of the Veterinary Research Laboratory. It was broadcast on the 23rd February at 11.30 a.m. on the 1st of the 2nd programme.

Disinfection: A disinfectant should be used to clean the areas within the infected area. This should be done by using a solution of 10% formalin. This should be applied to the floors, walls, and other surfaces.

After effects

The disease is highly infectious and may spread to other animals. It is important to isolate infected animals and to disinfect the areas they have occupied.

Vaccination

Vaccination is a method of preventing the disease by using a vaccine. This vaccine is made from a weakened form of the virus and is injected into the animal.

Bacon export

The export of bacon from Kenya is restricted to certain areas. This is to prevent the spread of the disease to other parts of the world.

Local control

Local control measures should be taken to prevent the spread of the disease. This includes isolating infected animals and disinfecting the areas they have occupied.

169 outbreaks

There have been 169 outbreaks of foot-and-mouth disease in Kenya since the start of the year. This is a significant increase from previous years.

Likely to stop development plans

The price of copra, which is still falling, is causing anxiety to the Government as it is likely to lead to a shortage of revenue. While copra maintained last year's price position was not serious but the fall, which is now about 30 per cent of that figure, is likely to put a stop to capital expenditure projects.

The fall is essential, price, especially cinnamon, due to the production of a cheaper substitute made from local goods and thus all the Colony's main exports are affected.

The price of four main products—cinnamon, nutmeg, cloves and vanilla—will increase in 1955, and the Government will be able to make changes in its price policy. It is expected that the new prices will be set by the end of the year.
