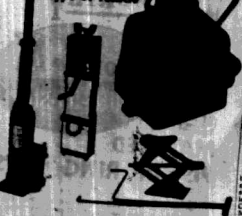

# New Constitution soon for Cyprus

## NO CHANGE OF SOVEREIGNTY

BRITAIN is preparing a new Constitution for Cyprus which will give the island a measure of self-government. It was announced by both the House of Lords and the House of Commons. Mr. H. Morrison, Minister of State for the Colonies, said that there was no change of sovereignty.

Aspirations had not yet been expressed by the Greek Cypriots. The British Government has given a fresh impetus to the movement, but "has not taken up any specific line of action."
