COMINGS APPROVES DECISION ON ANGLo-ITALIAN AGREEMENT

Some Conservatives Refrain From Voting On Issue

LABOUR'S MISGIVINGS

The House of Commons on Wednesday approved by 346 votes in 198 the Government's decision to bring into force the Anglo-Italian Agreement.

Mr. Chamberlain revealed that at Munich both Signor Mussolini and Herr Hitler had assured him they had no territorial aims in Spain or any of the Spanish possessions and that the Italian statesman had told him of his readiness to withdraw all Italian troops from the fighting in Spain as soon as the non-intervention plan became effective.

The Labour Opposition accused the Prime Minister of always making friends with the wrong people while Mr. Chamberlain said that the essential condition for the bringing into effect of the Agreement had not been fulfilled.

In making his statement of November 2 last, the Prime Minister approved for the Government's intention to bring the Anglo-Italian Agreement into force, the Prime Minister said that the Government was not a party to the agreement.
