KENYA GOVERNOR MAKES MANDATES STATEMENT

Clarification Of Prime Minister's Answer

MORE COMMONS QUESTIONS

IN THE KENYA LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL YESTERDAY, HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR QUOTED A TELEGRAM THAT HE HAD RECEIVED FROM THE COLONIAL SECRETARY STATING THAT MR. NEVILLE CHAMBERLAIN'S REPLY TO COMMONS QUESTIONS ON MONDAY ABOUT WHETHER THE GOVERNMENT WAS CONTEMPLATING A TRANSFER OF TERRITORY WAS A DEFINITE 'NO' WITHOUT PROVISION.

His Excellency referred to the statement made by Lord Baldwin, when he was Prime Minister in 1935, which was reaffirmed by Mr. Chamberlain on Monday, and of which one passage was "I think that a neat deal of the apprehension which Hon. Members claim exists on this subject must be due to the belief that His Majesty's Government have already been considering such a possibility, notwithstanding the details which have been given, and that the House might at some stage be faced with a decision on the subject. That apprehension is unfounded."

The Colonial Secretary, Mr. Macdonald, said in the House of Commons on Wednesday night that he had asked the Governor of Tanganyika for further information about their activities in Tanganyika. According to his questioner, the action was tantamount to the creation of a totalitarian state within a state.

The secretary, who has asked regarding an answer given by the Prime Minister in the House of Commons this week about the future of Mandates was relieved on Monday by a statement made by the Colonial Secretary in the House of Commons.

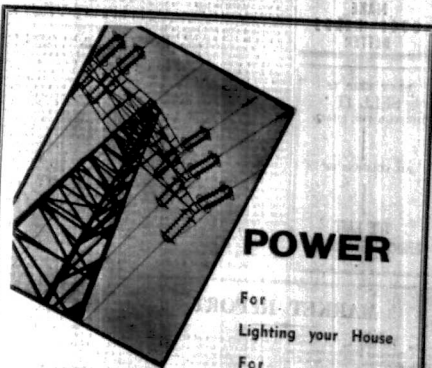

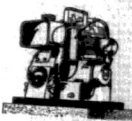

THE GENERAL LEVEL OF DUTY REDUCTIONS IN UNITED STATES MANUFACTURED GOODS WILL BE FROM 15 TO 38 PER CENT. REDUCTIONS ON BRITISH GOODS MOSTLY RANGE BETWEEN 30 AND 48 PER CENT AND COVER THE BULK OF BRITISH TEXTILES.**

The British Ambassador in America, Sir Ronald Lindsay, who was one of the signatories, acknowledged with gratitude, on behalf of the British Government, the restrictions made by the Dominions and India in order to facilitate the conclusion of the agreement.

Simultaneously with the signing of the Anglo-American trade pact, a Canadian-American agreement also based on "most favoured nation" treatment was signed.

Washington, November 18. The new Anglo-American Trade Agreement negotiated at the White House yesterday afternoon. At the same time the United States Government announced a new Trade Agreement to replace that which expired at the end of the year. The signatories were Sir Ronald Lindsay, British Ambassador in Washington, and Mr. Charles Boardman, Under Secretary of State for International Trade Affairs.

The White House ceremony marked the summit of six weeks of negotiations. The agreement covers a wide range of goods, including textiles, machinery, and agricultural products.

The agreement provides for a 38 per cent reduction in duties on many British goods, while British duties on American goods are reduced from 15 to 38 per cent.

**"READY FOR ANY EMERGENCY"**

**IN VIEW OF THE DISTURBED INTERNATIONAL OUTLOOK IT IS LIKELY THAT THE UNITED STATES NAVY WILL SOON BE BROUGHT UP TO FULL WAR STRENGTH.**

This course is recommended by the Secretary to the Navy who urges that the Fleet must be prepared for any emergency.

Washington, November 20.—The United States Navy Department has now awarded contracts for the construction of three of the four battleships for whose building Congress gave authority some time ago. The actual construction will not start until next spring and amounts will bring the total cost to about fifty million dollars.

The United States Secretary to the Navy, Mr. Frankford, published his annual report yesterday. The report contains a statement that the Fleet should be ready for any emergency at all present—the personnel of the Navy is sufficient to give the entire fleet 75 per cent of the full complement.

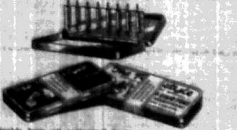
