BRITAIN AND ITALY SEND PLANES TO FINNISH FRONT

United States Also Hopes To Help

FINNS REPEL INVADERS

December 7. Evidence is accumulating to show that the Russians have taken on much more than they bargained for in their invasion of Finland. The vast mechanical machine which they placed so much confidence has been found to possess many disadvantages in the face of snow and the broken and wooded nature of the ground.

Completely conflicting reports of the fighting come from the respective sides. Finland claims to have repulsed all attacks and to have destroyed eighty enemy tanks. On the other hand, Russia says Soviet troops have broken through Finland's main defences—the Mannerline.

At least three countries are helping Finland directly. Britain and Italy are supplying the Finns with aeroplanes and war materials—some on Italian fighter planes are said to have already arrived—and President Roosevelt is hoping to put through a United States scheme which includes provision for Finland to purchase surplus cars on credit.

Direct help for Finland in the struggle against Russian invaders is being given by at least three countries—Great Britain, Italy and the United States.

The Finnish envoy to Sweden, who was formerly the Finnish Foreign Minister, was cheered to the echo and when an appeal was made for funds to help the Finns over-wedding rings were thrown into the air.

After the meeting the crowd cheered the Swedish Foreign Minister, who left for Oslo to confer with representatives of the other Scandinavian States. A resolution created by the Swedish invasion of Finland was adopted which called for the Swedish public to stand by the Finns.

The crowd made it clear that it is not only the Finns who are being helped but also the British. It is reported he is to be decorated. Recently the German Press has been bitterly attacking the German war.

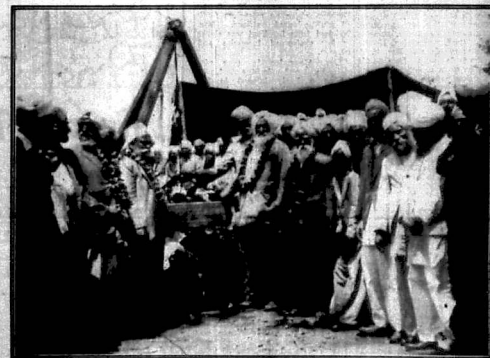

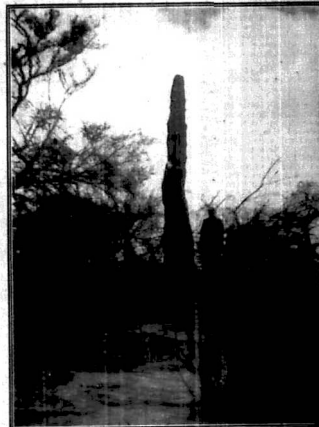
