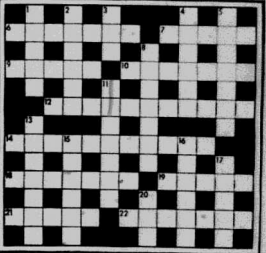

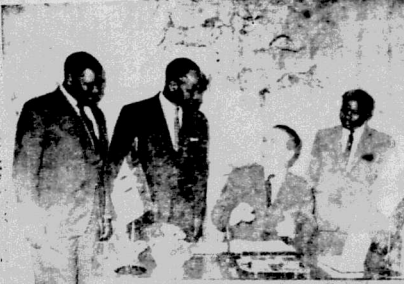

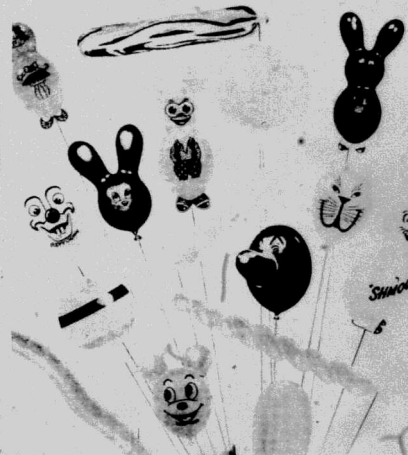
Posthumous award for Dr. King
