**South Africa holds £418m. in gold**

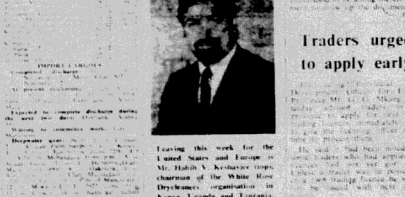
South African gold holdings increased to £418 million in the first week of the year, according to the latest figures from the Reserve Bank in Pretoria.

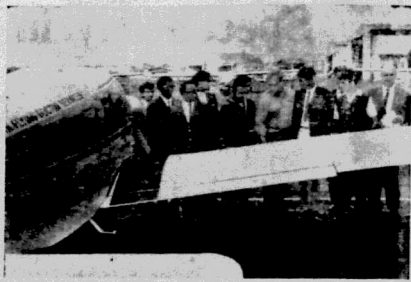
