The Council of Ministers has approved a new system of coffee export control which will be implemented from January 1, 1963. The new system is designed to tighten control over the export of coffee beans and to ensure that the maximum benefit is derived from the coffee industry.

The new system will require all coffee exporters to obtain a licence from the Ministry of Agriculture and Stock Raising. The licence will be issued on the basis of the exporter's production and will be valid for a period of 12 months.

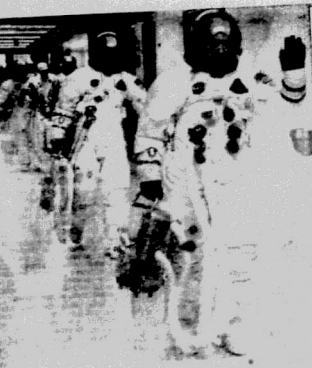

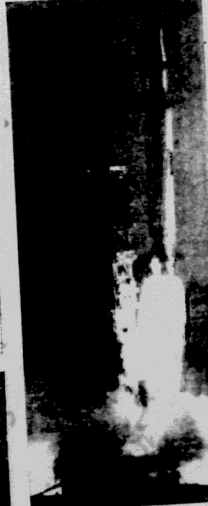

Three buried on Longnot after plane crash

Standard Staff Reporter

Grim-faced searchers found Willemijn Cornachi, light aircraft, missing since Christmas Eve, found it shattered and strewn over the floor of Mt Longnot crater on Saturday afternoon — its three young occupants dead.

The wreckage of the plane was found on the crater floor in a layer of flame-battered ash. The pilot, Willemijn Cornachi, was found in the wreckage, but his body was not recovered. The aircraft was identified by its registration number, N-1234.

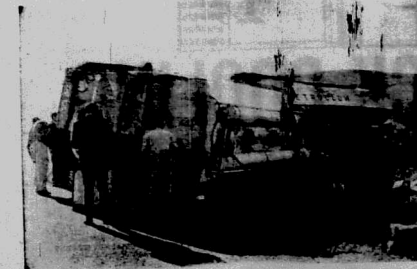

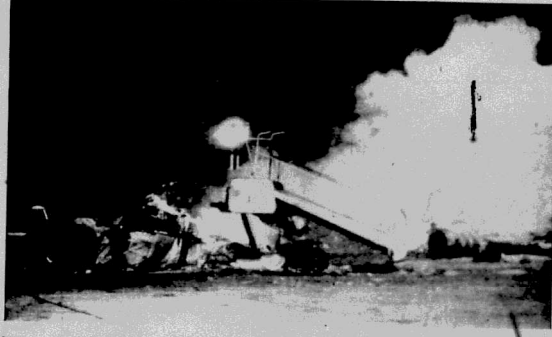

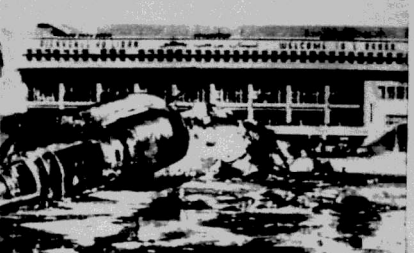
