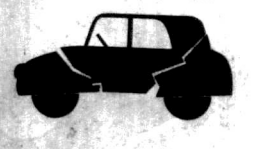

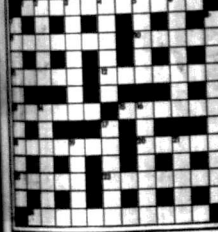

# Nairobi Council to issue Stock for £250,000

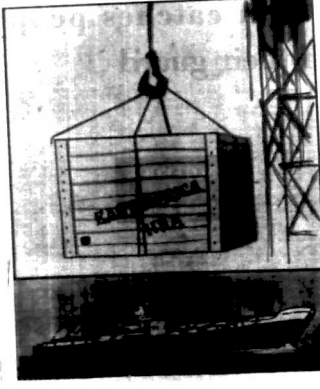

## Storm damaged by tail of cyclone

For ten hours, high winds and torrential rain buffeted the coast. No one was injured, despite winds which ripped the roofs from a number of houses in the Ukunda, Garu and Thiri areas.

"I have never seen anything like this," a fisher boatman said. "The wind started to blow unusual and it was impossible to distinguish the line of the sea by a sheet of white foam. The noise was terrific."

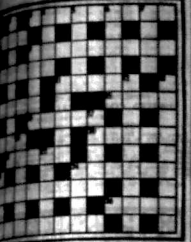

# 325m. DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR KENYA

## Public and private partnership

President Kenyatta yesterday launched a "war effort" to further the development of Kenya. Under the terms of the Revised Development Plan an additional 340,000 people will be found work and 2,000,000 will be invested during the next five years.

The plan which was presented by the Ministry of Economic Planning and Development, is a revision of the original 1959-70 Development Plan. The revised edition is contained in a 400-page volume and covers the period 1964-70. It is proposed that work on a further revision will start with a view to publishing a plan covering 1968-73.

Speaking at a Press conference at State House, President Kenyatta said: "The task is not an easy one. It requires not only technical and financial resources but also a high degree of national unity and a 'war effort' in the execution of the plan. This job can be done only if we rise above petty tribal and personal ambitions and work together in the spirit of harmony."

### Hopes of foreign aid

Speaking after the President, the Minister for Economic Planning and Development, Mr. Mboya, said that a total of £10,000,000 per cent would be provided by private investors and £15,000,000 by the Government or other public or semi-public organizations. The Minister said: "Out of total Government development expenditure of £20,000,000 we have good hopes of obtaining £8,000,000 from abroad in the form of loans or other financial grants."

The £10,000,000 to be raised from the country's own resources, Mr. Mboya pointed out, will be used to finance the Government's share of the plan. He added that most of the £21,000,000 in local resources must be found in the form of borrowing.
