THE idea of holding Commonwealth athletic meetings was first suggested in the late 19th Century.

In 1911 British, Australian, Canadian and South African athletes competed in a Festival of Empire Games at the Crystal Palace, London, as part of the Coronation celebrations.

Considerable interest was shown but the meeting, at the time was regarded as an isolated event and a notable occasion and there was no thought of repeating it at regular intervals.


