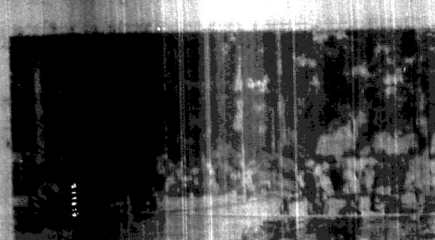

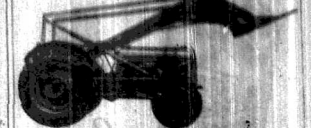

'STORING UP' PLANS FOR KENYA DAIRY HERDS COMPETITION
Stool Book Committee's new move

Consideration is being given to the possibility of storing up milk for the winter months, a move which would be a boon to the dairy industry.

The Stool Book Committee, which is the governing body of the dairy industry in Kenya, is planning to set up a milk storage scheme. This scheme would involve the collection of milk from the various stables in the country and its storage in large tanks for use during the winter months when the supply of fresh milk is low.

The committee is also planning to set up a milk processing plant, which would produce milk powder and other dairy products. This would provide a further source of income for the dairy farmers and help to meet the demand for these products in the country.

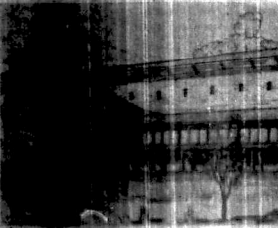
