ARRANGEMENTS for visits to Central Africa by the Colonial and Commonwealth Secretaries have been announced in the House of Lords. Mr. Patrick Gordon-Walker, Secretary of State for Commonwealth Relations, hoped to leave on September 10 for the territories in Southern Rhodesia.

Mr. Gifford and Mr. Gordon-Walker will be accompanied by Mr. Griffiths and Mr. Giddens, Under-Secretaries of State, respectively at Victoria Falls, with Mr. Griffiths as Minister and representative of the Rhodesia, Nyasaland, and Northern territories for the change of views, Lord Luce said.

"We would like the British Government to reach conclusions regarding the proposals for federation made to it by the London conference in March on close examination of the views of the territories."

Lord Luce said the Government would be pleased to receive constructive advice which would help to bring about a settlement of the proposals for federation.
