# KEYA P OF TRIPS TO PARKS

Standard Staff Reporter

ARRANGERS for visitors to Kenya's national parks are to increase substantially next year. The entry fee for a casual visitor will be raised from the present 5/- to 20/-. The fee for members will be raised from 5/- to 10/-.

The Director of National Parks, Mr. P. O. Olinde, said yesterday that the increases were necessary because of the rising financial requirements of existing parks and the planned opening of two more game sanctuaries next year.

Mr. Olinde said: "All I can say is that we are being heavily subsidised by the Government."

## Expenditure up

There had been an increase in the parks' recurrent expenditure following the takeover from the Meru County Council of the Meru National Park and up to June this year the total expenditure had been more than £200,000.

It was expected that there would be a further increase in recurrent expenditure amounting to £200,000 in the next few months.

Mr. Olinde said that the parks' recurrent expenditure was being met by the Government and the Kenya National Parks Authority. The Government was contributing 50 per cent of the total expenditure and the Kenya National Parks Authority was contributing the remaining 50 per cent. The Government was also contributing towards the capital expenditure of the parks.

## Egypt's fuel blankets Suez in smoke

A THICK cloud of smoke lay over Suez yesterday as Egypt's two major oil refineries continued to blaze hours after Tuesday's Israeli shelling.

The Governor of Suez, Mr. Hamed Mahmoud, told reporters that the Suez Canal Authority had been totally destroyed. Half of the other refinery, owned by the Suez Oil Processing Company had been knocked out of action.

Observers put Egyptian losses in the fires at about £700,000.

The red glow over the city was visible more than 20 miles away. Thick clouds of black smoke and flames were being blown across the Suez Canal.

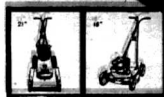

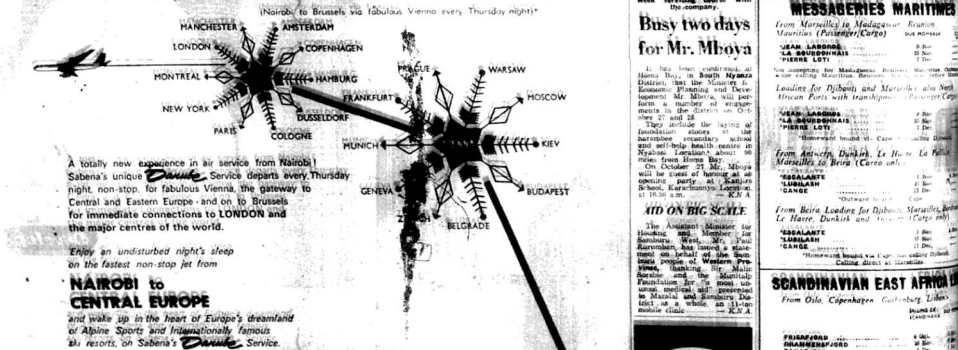

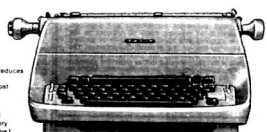

# Use force in Rhodesia

Mr. Fisher said that Mr. Obote had clearly put maximum calls among the Africans when speaking about Rhodesia. He had said two things which were not accurate. One was that the British Parliament was not concerned with Rhodesia.

Mr. Fisher said that what most Africans basically objected to was that Britain was not using force there. It is not only to use force there but to mount an invasion and start a 'hot war' with it.

This was never a possibility. Since 1848 Britain had had the strongest strength to wage a war on the continent of Africa. That might sound like a legal admission, but practically it was not.

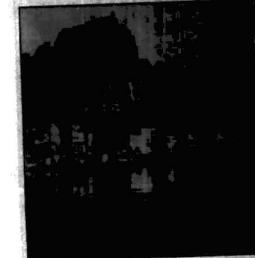

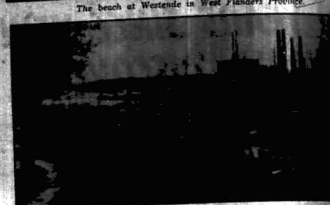

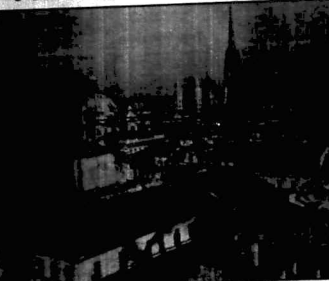
