

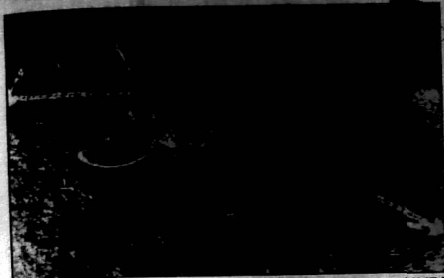

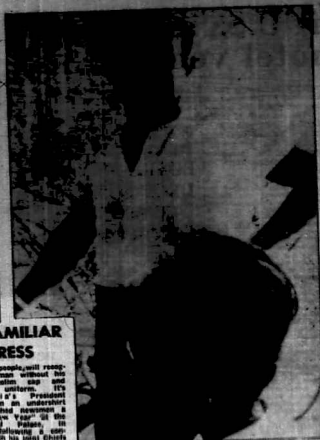

# Impoverished to help localisation

It remained axiomatic that given equal ability and character, employers would always prefer to take on local people rather than expatriates, apart from other considerations, the cost of maintaining expatriates was constantly escalating.

**MANY FACTORS**

"All our thinking should, I think start from that point," Sir Colin went on. "The nub of the problem is the relative weight to be given to the manifold political, emotional and economic factors and how one must decide that business and politics are often ill-adjusted and only moderately compatible. It is not a simple matter of business and politics which diverts them from the day-to-day running of their businesses on which the yardstick of their success or failure is measured. As the time a businessman can only ignore political and social factors to our peril."

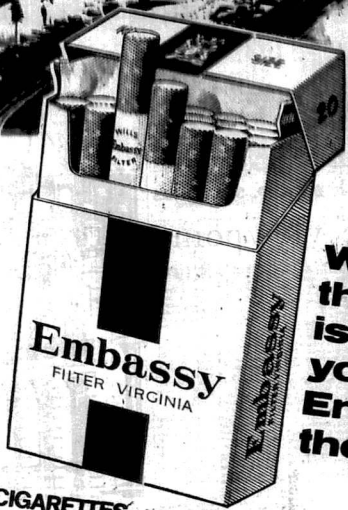

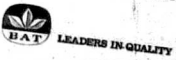

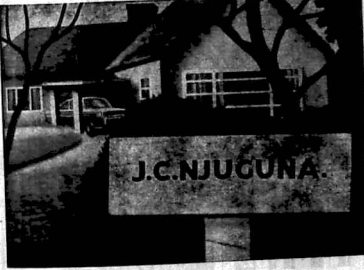
