ALL OF VIBORG IN RUSSIAN ADVANCE INTO SUBURBS

NEWS FROM FINLAND YESTERDAY WAS EXTREMELY GRAVE. TERRIFIC RUSSIAN PRESSURE HAS CAUSED THE FINNS TO RETREAT AND THE FALL OF VIBORG IS IMMINENT. THE SOVIET TROOPS CLAIM TO BE ONLY TWO KILOMETERS SOUTH OF THE CITY.

For from being disheartened, however, the Finns are fighting every inch of the ground and Soviet casualties are said to be enormous. The Finns have occupied new positions between Viborg and Vuolteen, and official messages from the capital say no reason for pessimism.

The terrific Russian pressure has caused the Finnish army to fall back on a line about half way across the Karelian Isthmus. This is a position which is not so well suited to the Finnish communications, which are fast enemy presence continued between the Bay of Viborg and the Gulf of Bothnia. The Finns were withdrawn to their new positions between Viborg and Vuolteen. Russian tanks are reported to have been destroyed in the new front and four tanks and one armoured car have been destroyed south of Lake Ladoga.

In Hangö it is recognized that the Russian advance is a grave matter and that the fall of the city is inevitable. It is stated that there is as yet any reason for optimism.

Graf Spee Wreck Bought For £1,000

The wreck of the German pocket battleship, Admiral Graf Spee, has been bought by a South American merchant for about £1,000. The ship originally cost over £4,000,000.

**Barbers About**  
The Town Council of Nairobi is divided about the barbers. All those who have been, resident in Kenya for any length of time know the African barber and take him for granted. He comes round the house and does his job of work quietly and apparently efficiently because nobody has seen an African whose hair was so untidy at the back that his wife would not get out with him till he got it cut. We never have to let the cook or the housewife go to the barber. The loose ends never hang untidily over his collar; they do not have to sprout like dozen hairs expertly over badly eroded area where the grazing has been ruined by overstocking. It is true that now and again we find a dandy who has had a permanent parting and which wide ploughs from front to back, and we don't like the look of it. We know also that many of the ladies, especially among the Swahili, seem to spend half their life and a great deal of their husband's money dressing their hair, and some what sadly we reflect that when Kipling compared the Colonel's lady with the O'Grady girl he knew what he was writing about because, colour of skin notwithstanding, she was the mother of the barber's business. But few of us thought that the City was a Municipal Corporation which might one day cause our City Fathers to stretch their heads or even tear their hair.

Yet so it is. The Council does not know what is the matter with the barber's business, but the barber's business is being controlled. They are even horrified to discover what we all know long ago that the African barber has partly solved the problem of what happens to razors blades, though he seldom reads all their names when he is not before he takes possession. We know, too, that a bit of an old bottle in the hands of a skilled technician can cut into an African head lock quite smart, so soft so soft we grade the old drop of gin when the probable reason that the bottle is empty the sooner will the barber replenish his stock.

Unfortunately the barber has now been given a slender reputation. From the time immemorial he has been the retailer of goodly paraphernalia and accessories. Some of the barber's shops were the fashionable resort of the lounge lizards. Every bit of material was known and respected, and barbers being what they are and their customers too, the passage of time has not altered much of their business, many a woman having her hair set spills the laces. Cutting hair has been a fairly innocuous occupation but in Nairobi it is not to be suspected because the idea has been 'branded' abroad that perhaps the barber is too interested in a haircut and a shave in a disconcerting hour, in the guise of a burglar, can snoop around during the day and find out which windows are left open at night. NAVAL CLAIMS MORE MODERATE THAN EXPECTED

GERMANY HAS ISSUED WHAT PURPORTS TO BE A RELATIVE GAIN OF THE NAZIS AND THE ALLIES DURING THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF WAR. NAVAL CLAIMS, THOUGH EXAGGERATED, ARE CONSIDERABLY MORE MODERATE THAN WERE EXPECTED—THE HIGH COMMAND APPEARS TO HAVE LEARNED THE FUTILITY OF "SINKING" SHIPS WHICH TURN UP AGAIN.

In a broadcast to German naval losses the statement leaves truth far behind and even less restraint is noticeable in the remarks about air warfare. According to the High Command German reconnaissance flights have enabled the Nazis to gain complete information about British movements.

The statement says 35 German 'planes have been shot down compared with 335 lost by the Allies, and adds that whenever British machines attempted to fly over Germany they were repulsed by fighters and anti-aircraft fire. Of course no mention is made of the fact that during last week alone R.A.F. planes were over Germany almost on every night and that Berlin has visited on four occasions.

The German High Command last night issued a review of the first six months of the war which purports to sum up the relative gains of Germany and the Allies.

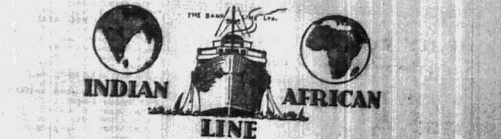

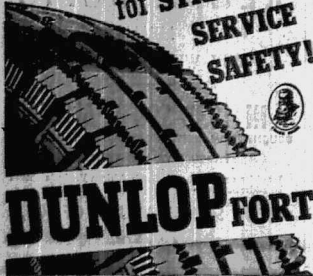

## Ship Set On Fire And 108 People Killed

### NAZI FRIGHTFULNESS

The British Admiralty yesterday revealed details of the most ruthless attack Nazi aircraft have yet made on a merchant ship.

AS A BRITISH LINER WHICH HAD ON BOARD A LARGE NUMBER OF BRITISH INDIA SUBJECTS RECENTLY RELEASED BY THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT WAS ON ITS WAY FROM ANTWERP IT WAS BOMBED AND MACHINE-GUNNED BY A GERMAN HEINKEL BOMBER.

Three of the four bombs dropped struck the ship which was set on fire. Over a hundred people were killed and others were injured.

One hundred and twenty people have lost their lives as a result of the attack on the passenger liner, the British India ship, Saturday morning.

The vessel was the British India liner, the *Domina*, of 8,400 tons. She had just sailed from Antwerp, after picking up 143 British India subjects released by the German Government who were being repatriated. The liner was followed down the coast by a German bomber which bombed and machine-gunned her in the early hours of Saturday morning.

The official statement issued by the Admiralty was in the following terms:

"Between four and five o'clock on the morning of March 3 in the light of a waning moon a German Heinkel bomber overtook the British steamer *Domina*, of 8,400 tons, and dropped four bombs of which three struck her.

"This was a passenger ship which had sailed from Antwerp with 143 British India subjects who had been released by the German Government and were being repatriated. The captain was killed and she broke out amides. The sea at the time was rough and the vessel was struck by a wave of force which caused the majority of the passengers and crew. Many of the survivors were injured. The ship is now at anchor in port."

Thought It Was British  
The quartermaster of the liner stated that the enemy plane flew over the half-damaged ship with full recognition lights, and he thought it was a British machine. It was only afterwards that he learned it was a Heinkel.

Most Careful Consideration  
It was stated in London today that the Italian navy will receive the most rapid and careful consideration and the British Government will be as accommodating as possible because of the friendly relations which exist between Britain and Italy. But in view of Germany's indiscriminate sea warfare on international law.

# FINNS ORDERLY RETREAT TO NEW POSITIONS

## Russians Still Outside Viborg

The Russians are gradually encircling Viborg although they seem to be making little progress towards the occupation of the city. The Finns are making their fight every inch of the way and the Soviet forces are suffering heavy losses.

The Army of Peace  
In Moscow, Soviet journals review the first six months of the war, and one of the Government organs, after referring to the success of the Red Army, says: "The Soviet Union is the only country whose army does not retreat any more." (Reuter.)

Hand to hand fighting is still going on in the suburbs of Viborg, while the main body of the Finnish army is retreating in good order and according to plan to new defensive positions. Their new line, to the north-west, is about three miles from Viborg at its deepest point and is based on the natural features of the country. It is about the same length as the original Mannerheim Line.

This morning's report from Helsinki says that while fighting is still going on in front of Viborg the Russians are also appearing vigorously in the centre of the Mannerheim Line.

Enemy Checks  
At the eastern end of the Karelian Isthmus the Finns claim that their artillery had disposed of two Soviet tanks which were concentrating for attack. North-east of Lake Ladoga fighting continues, but Finnish attempts to advance have been checked.

In the Tappari district it is estimated that the Russians have not gained one inch of ground in the past few weeks. Fighting over the past few weeks has been considerable activity in the air on both sides. The Finns in their last night's communiqué claim to have shot down 17 Russian planes on Saturday while the Finns say they have destroyed seven Finnish planes.

Russian Denial  
A Moscow broadcast that night denied that Russian planes have bombed Viborg in Finland, but a Finnish report issued today states that 500 people were killed and over 1,000 injured in Finland during the first three months of war. Another statement was issued this morning by the Russians replying to the Finns.

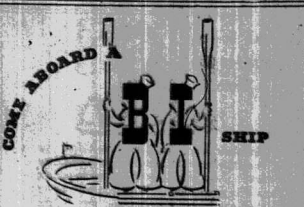

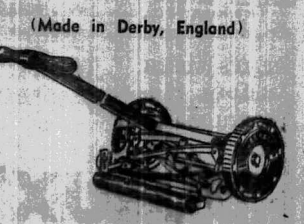

With her 12,000 miles of coastline and small population Australia had to rely on a great force for her defence. He said that a trade agreement would make 30,000 jobs available and other jobs available wherever their cooperation is necessary.

Mr. Menzies criticised the argument that the victory of Hitler would facilitate in a recent election when the Labour coalition in winning from across without a landslide. Investigators Simulate A Real Interest

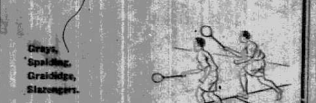
