Friendly start to Geneva conference

TIME FOR ALL 'CURTAINS' TO COME DOWN

WESTERN and Russian leaders yesterday started their historic "summit" conference in Geneva to seek a means of ending the "cold war" and ending the tensions which have gripped the world for nearly a decade.

President Eisenhower, Mr. Anthony Eden, Mr. Premier Bulganin met in a friendly atmosphere in the Palace of Nations where the Indo-Chinese War was ended nearly a year ago. After being welcomed by the Swiss Federal Secretary-General, Mr. Dag Hammarskjöld, the three leaders for the first two sessions appeared to meet in private. Among the main points in the opening address were:

MR. EDEN: A united Germany should not have armed itself against those envisaged for Western Germany as a result of the Western European Union. Western Germany should be free to join the Paris Agreement, that it should be free to obtain recognition of Germany or modification of frontiers.

MR. ANTHONY EDEN: Britain would be prepared to discuss any matter which would help to bring about a friendly settlement of the Berlin question.
