## ATOM POWER PROGRESS ON SHOW AT GENEVA

BRITAIN has become the world's greatest exporter of radio isotopes, used in radiography and the curing of many diseases, according to Government booklets released in London yesterday. Shipments last year reached about 20,000 kg.

The booklet, which covers the Commonwealth's contribution to nuclear research since the beginning of this century, was published to coincide with the opening of the Geneva conference on the peaceful use of atomic energy. Radio isotopes have the advantage of being cheap, maintenance problems are few, and without any of the pollution problems of industry.

The booklet hinted that by 1965, Britain's 12 nuclear power stations to be built under a five-year programme of a £500,000,000 might be saving 3,000,000 tons of coal a year and meeting one quarter of the United Kingdom's electricity needs. The station at Calder Hall, Cumberland, which is to begin operations next year, is always among the British exhibits at the exhibitions opened in Geneva yesterday by the I.N.S.E. General Secretary, Sir James D. MacLennan, M.P.

The opening of the exhibition, giving a preview of the atomic age, marked the start of the 13-day 'year for peace' conference, which will be attended by scientists from 75 countries.

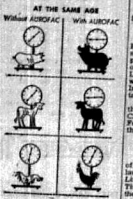

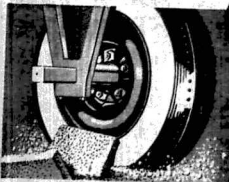
