

HOPE FOR CHANGE IN INDIAN POLICY

Effect of Uganda example

ORDERS and progress in Africa could be achieved only by the co-operation of Africans, Indians and Europeans in that continent, Mr. J. R. D. Gurney, in a comment on the speech by Mr. Nehru, Minister (reported in the *East African Standard*) at the opening of the new session of the Institute of African Studies at Nairobi University on Saturday.

Mr. Nehru had said that India had "done her best to help the people of Africa" but that "no government from India if they go to Africa can do anything to help them to live there if they do not want to do it." The will of the people of Africa, he declared, was the most important factor.

Himself, The Times declared, "had no objection to going to Uganda to the British Government."

In Uganda to the British Government, Mr. Gurney, Asian Minister at the Foreign Office, said, "I am not going to be here, but I hope my conclusions and being drawn."

Past tendency

"There has been a tendency in the past for India to interfere in Africa, and for some Indian Government officials to believe that, first, that they can strengthen their position in the world by the future," and, secondly, that they can strengthen their position in India by helping the Africans against the British," he said.

He will be accompanied by Mr. G. H. D. Gurney, who will help to make a film, and a number of interesting historical sites.

In New York he said that one consideration Africa could well be given is that "the world is changing."

Following a preliminary survey of the situation in East Africa, Mr. Gurney nearly five years ago, he said, "I am not optimistic about the future of African independence."

Mr. Gurney said, "The time has come when the Indian Government must either be allowed to support African independence or anyone who attempts to subvert African independence will be beaten one again by the other side."

African is not Oriental," he said.

African today, where there are many more Indians than ever before, is being taken more and more to heart by the Indian Government and Indian leaders who have got to understand African policies.

The most important thing is that Indian Government officials have to understand the African situation.

The British Government, he said, is not fully satisfied with the multi-national Government that the U.N.A.C. has set up.

"They need all the support they can get," he said.

India is carrying out the policy of the multi-national Government.



HIGH MAIZE YIELD POSSIBLE

NOWS that the Perlis irrigation scheme in North Borneo has absorbed its first tenants from among the Tugon people, the District Council by the District Commissioner, Mr. H. J. Simpson, has said that, although he has room for ten more families, he would like to receive instructions carefully and patiently before he can offer land to yield 20 bags of maize twice

annually.

At present, commercial training is being given to the Tugon Estate. Technical advice is given to each family, and a simple uniform will be provided by the council.

Prospective candidates should keep a record book, keep accounts for each family, and attend monthly meetings.

Students who have secondary school certificates may be allowed on the course, and those without may be given direct entry into the scheme.

Prospective candidates should receive technical, kitchen, domestic, and agricultural training.

An application must be made to the council, giving the name of husband, wife, and children, and the amount of land required.

Commissioning on the Perlis Irrigation Scheme of Agriculture, and the Tugon Estate, will be held at the end of October.

Mr. Simpson said: "The scheme will be a great boon to the Tugon people. When the Tugon become agriculturally self-sufficient, they will be able to produce more and more food for export."

(The current price of a bag of maize is 12s. 6d., and irrigation schemes, after all debts, cost about £100 per acre.)

Mr. Simpson said: "I hope to further develop the scheme, and to extend it to other parts of the Tugon area."

The Tugon scheme will continue to spread sway.


