## MOVE FOR UNIFIED HOSPITAL INSURANCE

An amendment to the Health Treatment Bill (Asian and Arab) Ordinance published in the Kenya Gazette yesterday is the Kenya Government's first step to introduce a possible one hospital insurance authority for all people earning more than a certain income.

The Bill aims at changing the name of the Asian and Arab Hospital Fund Authority to the Kenya Hospital Insurance Corporation and to empower that body to administer contributions from people of any income.

The Bill also provides for the introduction of a new class of hospital insurance for people earning more than a certain income.

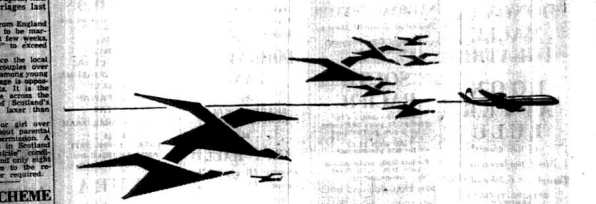

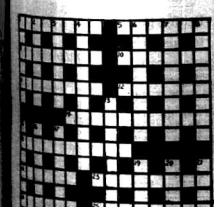

# South Africa trade banned from Africa

Parliamentary Commission on the Government and its relations with South Africa has announced that it will recommend that trade with South Africa be banned.

# SOomalis protest against shifita murders

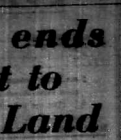
