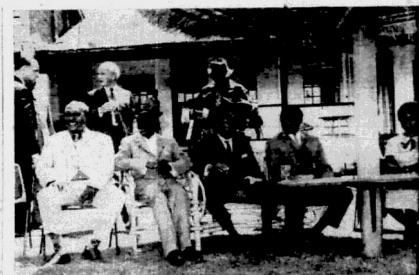

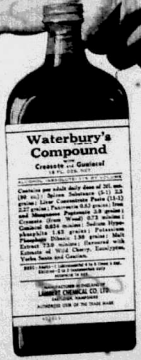
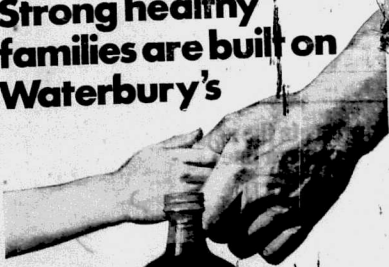

The Czechoslovak Communist Party Secretary, Mr. Dubcek, Premier Oldrich Cernik and the Slovak Party Secretary, Mr. Husak, arrived in Moscow yesterday from Prague aboard a Huskavia airliner.

Mr. Dubcek, dressed in a grey overcoat and striped grey suit, was warmly applauded at Prague Airport by a crowd of about 100 people.

The crowd was split as Mr. Cernik (Chairman of the Soviet Embassy) entered the airport. Asked about the date of the visit to Moscow, Mr. Cernik said the visit would last for a few days.

After a brief discussion in the airport lounge the Czechoslovak leaders went on to the airport club, where they were met by the red faces of Soviet officials. The red faces were expected to open a special round of talks with Soviet leaders on the situation in their occupied country, a Czech Embassy spokesman said in Moscow.

As a prelude to the talks, the Soviet Press yesterday made it clear that the occupation was being conducted with the intention of leading to the formation of a new government. It was said that the occupying troops were not to be allowed to interfere with the work of the Czechoslovak government.

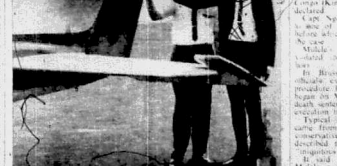

These negotiations, export commitments of maize, barley, wheat, cottonseed cake and similar produce have to be checked for information by port guards employed by the Ministry. Delays in the shipment of produce are best avoided by fumigating such consignments.
A revolutionary process introduced to East Africa by the London-Funguon Company Limited has speeded the fumigation of goods, which as far as export large quantities of fumigating agents, such as phosphine, at Mombasa. 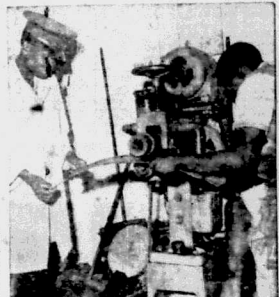

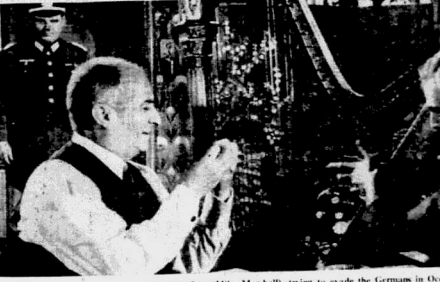
