Egypt claims to have shot down Israeli planes

Egypt has claimed to have shot down three Israeli planes and destroyed a fourth yesterday in an air battle over Israel, on the Sinai Canal, but Israel denied that it had lost any planes in the incident.

An Egyptian military spokesman said the three planes were downed and the fourth crashed on the floor of the Canal at 2 p.m. It said an Israeli pilot managed to parachute to safety on the Canal East Bank.

A number of Egyptian MiG-17 fighters were also downed in the air battle, the spokesman added.

Israel's Ministry of Defense in Tel Aviv, however, the Israeli spokesman said, "has not received any reports from the Israeli pilots shot down by Israeli aircraft. All Israeli planes reported to have been shot down yesterday were destroyed by Israeli fighters in the Sinai Peninsula."

The spokesman also reported several Egyptian shooting incidents on Wednesday across the Sinai Peninsula, but said that Israeli claims reported were not substantiated by Egyptian intelligence of first rank of the Egyptian Air Force in the Sinai Peninsula.

From Tel Aviv, it was reported that an Israeli patrol caught a group of Arab infiltrators in the Sinai Peninsula. One of the infiltrators was killed and the other was wounded. The incident took place near the border of the Jordan Valley. The Israeli spokesman said that the infiltrators were not on the Israeli side of the border. 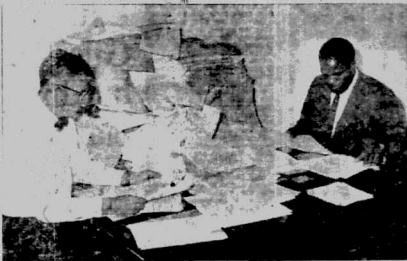

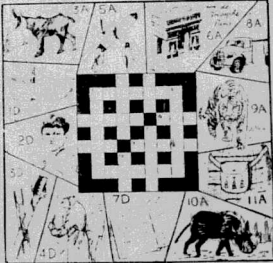
