## CONFERENCE A BIG TEST FOR PREMIER

Anxious to avoid split

THE British Prime Minister, Mr. Harold Wilson, was determined to have a major triumph in Britain's political war of nerves of the Chinese-Premier's annual conference.

The week-long conference is a big test for Mr. Wilson, who has been under pressure from his supporters.

### U.S. would confer with China

M. Arthur Goldberg, the United States Ambassador to the United Nations, said yesterday that a U.S.-China conference would be held — but only after it had been determined that it would be in the interests of disarmament.

Mr. Goldberg, who is also a member of the U.S. delegation taking part in a peace conference in Geneva, said that China also participated and they had to talk to each other. "It would be a most unprofitable conference," he said.

Mr. Goldberg said that the U.S. had carried on extensive talks with China and with the United States and concluded from them that it was better to have the parties meet to discuss their differences than to go to a question of whether or not to go to war.

Mr. Goldberg said that at present, as far as the U.S. was concerned, China's administration in China.

He said that the U.S. had adopted a non-aggressive attitude directly opposed to the U.S. Chinese.

### S. AFRICAN MINISTER MAY ADDRESS U.N.

THE South African Foreign Minister, Dr. Muller, has pencilled in his name on several dates when he may speak to address the United Nations General Assembly on Wednesday, October 3, on World Day, according to informed sources.

However, there was no certainty that he would attend the general debate on world affairs which is intended to last for two days.

Dr. Muller, who is due to leave on Friday, October 5, to attend the Commonwealth Conference in London, has decided to take a break during his stay.

It was understood that three days would be sufficient for him to get back to South Africa and in both the morning and afternoon he would be available.

This is still about a tentative date, however.

Questioned about the possibility of Dr. Muller attending, one Western and one Asian delegate might have been referring to his appearance and not his actual presence.

"We are not worried about Dr. Muller's absence," said one Western delegate. "He did not take part in the previous session."

It was more of less taken for granted that the African delegates would try to express African opinion by making a statement in Dr. Muller's absence.

Dr. Muller has the right of reply in his statement.

**CLARA BOW DIES AT 60**

Clara Bow, the red-haired star of the 1920's, died yesterday at her home in New York City, only 14 days after her 60th birthday. She had suffered from a heart attack at her home in the Bronx, New York.

The giant screen siren was all set ready for service in December when she was cast in the lead role in the Persian Gulf ports to Japan for the Calico-affiliated Wagners Co.

In her later years she was a successful author and a highly intelligent woman who painted and wrote poetry but who rarely went out.

### TALKS TO TRY TO SOLVE CRISIS

FRANCE's boycott of the Common Market and the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) has been broken in the autumn Council of Europe meeting in Paris, yesterday.

Delegates talked today at Western European Union.

The working week in the EEC, Common Market countries will be reduced to 40 hours by the first of January, France said, starting the Market's first year.

The report added: "The Assembly's position is that the political situation in Europe is stable and must be allowed to continue."

But it also says that the EEC would threaten the Common Market if it gave rise to "recriminations throughout Europe" and that "the Danish Foreign Minister, Mr. Hans Christian Pihl, has asked for a report."

The Assembly's report also said that "the economic situation is stable, economic, cultural, scientific, technical, etc."



Most of the students had been born in Kenya, and many had friends and relatives there. They had a sense of friendliness and co-operation about them which the Commonwealth website.

## LITTLE AID, MORE PEOPLE

ONE of the greatest problems facing world leaders is the ever-widening gap between the rich, industrialized nations and the poor, underdeveloped countries. According to the World Bank, the rate of population growth is nearly everywhere. The two are closely related and on their solution the future of mankind depends.

The World Bank's latest report on the situation in Africa, published last month, showed that the continent's population had increased by 10 per cent since 1960. The report also said that the growth continues at a rate of 2.5 per cent per annum. But this period has seen a marked increase in the number of people per unit area in Africa and this added to more intensive agriculture has forced the continent to import food. Some experts have found that the increasing numbers could easily double the continent's food requirements by the year 2000 if no new capital is invested in the next five years. This has been pointed out by the World Bank.

With such additional vast areas to farm, the present situation is likely to continue. The present situation will not improve unless there is a marked increase in aid to the continent. This is an indication that the world must take a more active role in helping the developing countries to develop their economies and to move towards self-sufficiency.

It has to be attended. And though it may be true that it is the responsibility of the developing countries and their poorer brothers from abroad, an equal responsibility lies with the developed countries.

Most of the aid received by developing countries comes in the form of imports. This is a major factor in the rise of increasing living standards. This is mainly because the developing countries are able to buy more food for their growing populations.

It is clear that if we are to reduce the population, the developed countries will have to help to destroy the poverty in the developing countries, and there is also a strong chance of increased racial tension.

### Knitwear and leather in Italian fashions

Up to ten years ago the reaction to Italian fashion and accessories was usually "If it's Italian it's good — but expensive." More recently, however, with modern production methods the Italians have managed to bring many of their fashion articles of luxury class without losing high standards of quality and design. Knitwear is one of the fastest-growing areas of Italian fashion; the knitwear industry employs some 33,000 workers in Italy and produces about 100 million items of knitwear per year. The value of the Italian knitwear market, customer, U.S. buyers took over £25 million in 1963. This figure is expected to rise to £30 million by 1965. The Italian knitwear industry is well known for its variety of products, such as socks, mittens, coats, suits, sweaters, etc., and its ability to produce them in a reasonable range, at reasonable prices. The Italian leather goods industry is third in the world in terms of quality and design. It is well known for its leather goods, particularly handbags, which are quickly recognized in the world.

The leather goods industry in Florence, Modena, Mantua and Venice is one of the three leading production centers of Italy. The leather goods industry has shown a certain slackening in recent years, but the export market is reflected in increasing export figures.

**THE ITALIAN tractor and farm machinery industry is at the present, in full development to meet both the tractor section. It prevails the manufacture of small tractors, power models, both of which have a driving belt. In the production of these models Italy occupies, among the European countries, a prominent position.**


