The importance of the efficiency and good organization of the only contribution Kenya could make to Imperial Defence—man-power, of what was described as unimpaired calibre—was stressed when the Kenya Regiment (Territorial Force) and the Kenya Auxiliary Force Bill were passed in Legislative Council on Thursday.

The acceptance of the Select Committee reports on both Bills were made by Mr. J. H. Morris, Director of Education, and seconded by Lord Francis Scott.

Despite many amendments, the only important changes concerned definition of active service, the law which will operate in the Forces during active service, age limits, and the alteration of the name of the Auxiliary Force to the traditional title, "Kenya Defence Force."

## FRANCO'S GRIP TIGHTENS ON MADRID

### GOVERNMENT'S DESPERATE DEFENCE

**Against Force of 32,000**

### FRANCO'S DEFENDER VISITS LITH NORTH EAST SECTOR

With 32,000 Insurgents, supported by aircraft and tanks sweeping down Guadalajara, the Government have being reinforcements into the battle and General Miaja himself has left Madrid and is visiting the north east front.

The Government claim that they have consolidated defensive positions and the Insurgents estimate that their advance troops are now within 15 miles of Guadalajara. 





### SWEEPING ALLEGATIONS BY MADRID DEFENDER

#### Blackshirts Near Guadalajara

#### GOVERNMENT CLAIM SUCCESSFUL COUNTER ATTACK

Madrid, March 11. We are openly fighting against Italy," declared General Miaja, commanding Madrid defenses today. It is officially declared that there are several Italian blackshirt divisions and one Italian regular army division on the Guadalajara front, commanded by Italian Generals under supreme command of General Muzini.

The Government claim that in a counter-attack on the insurgent positions between Brihuega and Valdepenas they regained ground they had lost and inflicted terrific losses on the insurgents.

The insurgent headquarters at Salamanca declared that despite enemy attacks and freezing cold the insurgent push to the south had been stopped. After the capture of Brihuega two insurgent columns went on north-west and south with the object of linking up with the insurgents in the Guadarrama mountains on one flank and Toledo on the other.

#### From Abyssinia to Spain

Madrid, March 12. The insurgent offensive in the north-east has been stopped, 1000 casualties among them, it was announced. There is an artillery barrage put on throughout the night by the Government on the road approaching Guadalajara in an attempt to stop the insurgents. Heavy fighting tanks were also used.

According to an announcement by General Quiroga, 1000 men from Seville, 500 men of the Guardia Civil, amounting to 140000 men, were loaded from the steamer "Maracanthine" which had been captured by the insurgents and was now bound for Ferrol harbor. General Quiroga stated that the battle would be used against the insurgents.

London, March 11. A striking description of Britain's efforts to reorganise the Navy was given by Sir Samuel Hoare, introducing the Navy Estimates in the House of Commons this afternoon.

He said that the Navy was forced, owing to past inaction, to telegraph into two or three years what normally would be carried out in a decade. Now the House was asked to approve expenditure of over £100,000,000 and a construction programme of eighty ships in all.
