IRISH BUDGET

Indirect Taxation to be Reduced

(MUSOLINI BUREAU'S AGENT.) Dublin, April 15. The Irish Free State Budget was introduced in the Dail yesterday by the Finance Minister, Mr. McManis, who announced a reduction of indirect taxes on tea, sugar and butter and the removal of duties on wheat. He expects a considerable surplus for the year and will use nearly all of it to reduce indirect taxation. In the course of a two-hour speech the Finance Minister explained the improved outlook.

BRITAIN'S TRADE IN MARCH

Best For Nearly Seven Years

(MUSOLINI BUREAU'S AGENT.) London, April 15. Board of Trade returns for March issued tonight show that last month's exports totaled £43,400,000—the highest of any month since November, 1933. Imports were £28,900,000, an increase of £1,600,000 compared with February and £1,400,000 compared with January. The balance of trade was £14,500,000, corresponding to a surplus of £1,500,000.

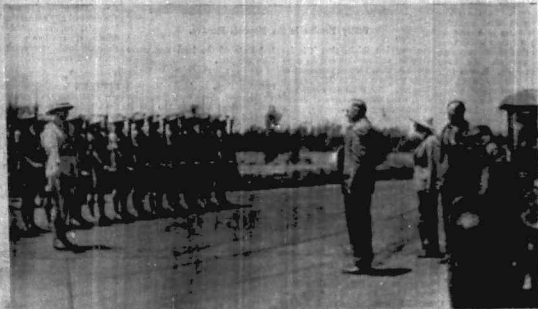

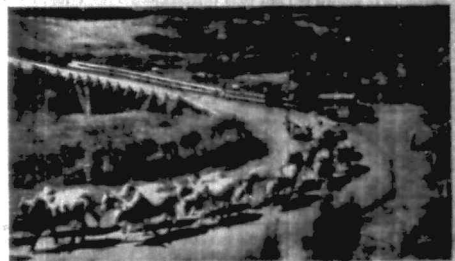

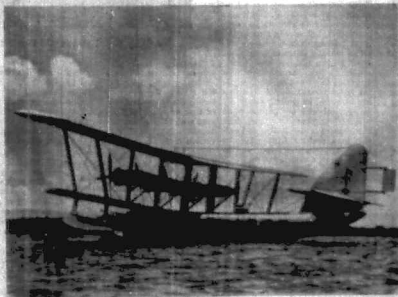

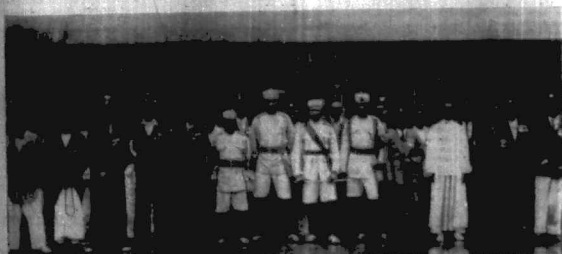

Search For Heirs To \$4,500,000 Fortune

HOUSTON RELATIVES WILL FIGHT TESTACY

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.]

At least 15 relatives of Lady Houston will share in the fortune she left.

In addition to her sister, Mrs. Frances Wray, they include a brother, two nephews, a nephew, and the children of other relatives. The children of some of the nephews are not known, but they are believed to be in Australia.

Lady Houston's fortune will be disposed of as if she had died intestate. Her will has been proved and cleared in the fact that Miss Juliana Margaret Hoare, an aunt of the deceased, was to whom the estate was left, died nearly six months before her.

The interest of the estate in England and the estimated value of the London estate total roughly \$4,500,000. This is approximately the sum left to Lady Houston by her husband in 1908, after payment of £1,000,000 in settlement of the husband's death estate claim on the Jersey estate.

Mr Robert Houston bequeathed £100,000 of the £700,000 fortune to Mr George Henry Appleton, of Liverpool, who had been his confidential adviser and friend for nearly 30 years.

The Trustee has not yet considered what action, if any, will be taken to claim death duties on Lady Houston's estate in Jersey. Now estimated at £2,000,000, duties of £600,000 on the English estate of £1,200,000 have already been paid.

A member of the firm of Nicholson, Graham and Jones, the solicitors acting for the beneficiaries, stated yesterday that liability for duties on the Jersey estate would depend on the question of domicile. Any claim, he added, would be resisted.

CHILDREN STARVE when PARENTS QUARREL

London Couple's Tragic Story

LEPT INFANTS IN EMPTY HOUSE

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.]

London, April 16. A Quarrel between a father and mother, both of whom had left the children in the custody of a Polish Count yesterday—that the other had committed the heinous act to the death by starvation of their two children at Cranford-crescent, St. Michael's, school holidays near discovered 12 hours after their parents had left.

The parents, Percy Davis, aged 31, a labourer, of Mansell Park, London, and Mrs. Mary Davis, aged 28, of Oldbridge-crescent, St. Michael's, were charged with the manslaughter of the two children, Edward John Davis, aged 1; and Kenneth, aged 1; by willful neglect. They have pleaded not guilty, and were remanded for re-arrest to the Central Criminal Court.

The infants were married in 1922. There had been quarrels, and on March 4, Davis, having gone to work, had his wife for some going on for the day.

"I Have Gone Away"

Mrs. Davis said that if he went she was going. There had been discussions before she had departed. On that day Mrs. Davis had the children in her five o'clock, packed some clothes, and left the house, leaving the 64-year-old mother for her husband.

"I have gone away. You need not try to get me back. I am not coming home."

Normally Davis returned home at 7.30 p.m., but he did not go home that night. He went to the house where he had promised to meet a friend. Park-road, and arranged to lodge with a Mr. and Mrs. Cohen, who had had left his wife.

Mrs. Davis went to a married sister, a Mrs. King, at Elmington, Wick, saying she had left her husband because of his drinking, and had put the children to bed for her husband to attend to when he woke them.

Crying Alone

"Since leaving home, Davis had sent his wife a registered envelope containing a £1 note and a postal order for £6, and Mr. Davis, the postman called three times, but was unable to get an answer."

On Sunday, March 7, a telephone message in the house, but as soon as she knelt at the door the crying ceased and she did not weep further. No further news had been heard from the children.

"He was in the room unless he could stand long enough for people to hear him," said Mrs. Davis.

SOCIETY WOMEN MOB ELEPHANT BOY

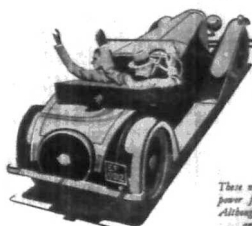
