Pelerin, Treat Gift for Preservation

LIVINGSTONE LETTERS

London, April 17.
The Trustees of the Pelerin Trust have granted £1,500 for the preservation and publication of the original letters and records of the London Missionary Society, which are housed at the House, Broadway, Westminster. The trustees have taken a personal interest in the preservation of the original letters and documents relating to the society's work in Africa, India, China, South Seas, Madagascar, Papua, and the West Indies. The archives consist of personal journals and letters from missionaries to friends of the society.

Some of the most valuable of the archives, which in early days of the Society's history were the property of the society, are the diary of David Livingstone, which he kept from 1841 to 1853, and his diary from 1853 to 1877, and his diary from 1877 to 1893, when he was a member of the London Missionary Society in Africa. His first visit was in 1842, many years before the arrival of other white settlers.

A faded letter and tattered book have brought visions of wealth to an unemployed laborer Mr. Ernest Jordan of Tevelbury, Gloucestershire, states a "New Christian" article.
The letter, dated Venice, 1855, is signed 'Byron' and the book, published in Paris in 1826, is believed to be a first edition containing all poems, including those approved in England, by the poet.
Mr. Jordan attended a sale of books at Tevelbury Park, house of the late Mr. J. Newport and the first bundle was sold for a shilling on Mr. J. 11 day, the local historian.
"He took what he fancied from his bundle and gave me the rest," said Mr. Jordan.
"Later, I was inspecting the books I had received when a letter fell out of one volume. It was the signature 'Byron.' It gave me a shock!"

The letter is addressed to the Editor of 'Gleanings of Europe', Paris, and appeared to be the rough draft of a note sent by Byron from Venice on April 27, 1819.

Blockade Defeated

BILBAO'S DELIRIOUS WELCOME TO THREE BRITISH FOOD SHIPS

Britain's biggest battleship figured in an exciting incident attending the successful running of the Bilbao blockade by three British food ships.

As the British merchant vessels, all outside the three mile limit, were steaming towards the port, insurgent warships appeared on the scene and fired either at the food ships or across their bows.

Thompson H.M.S. "Hood" intervened with the warning that if the molestation continued the mole would take action. The insurgent vessels quickly steamed away.



BILBAO "BLOCKADE" DISAPPEARS

SUCCESSFULLY RUN BY TEN SHIPS

General Franco's Protest

GOERING AND MUSSOLINI TO DISCUSS REBEL FAILURE?

Ten ships have reached Bilbao up to yesterday, since the imposition of the Spanish Insurgent "blockade."

The Insurgent Government has strongly protested against the "flagrant violation of neutrality" committed by British warships in preventing Rebel gunboats from stopping British cargo vessels.

The "continual inability of General Franco to win the war" is said to be seriously perturbing Signor Mussolini's General Goering, who was expected to discuss Spain, among other topics, at a meeting yesterday.

Britain is replying with a counter protest against Spain with three British merchant ships.

British Counter Protest

(Master and Official Wireless Service)

April 26. The British Ambassador in London, Sir Horace Rumbold, has been instructed to send a protest to the Insurgent Government against the interference with three British merchant ships off Bilbao on April 25.

It is stated that the reported protest by the Burgos Government has not yet been received. The "Lancet" Commercial Correspondent, now registered in London, has arrived at Santander with a cargo of blockades. There was no incident during the voyage. The Glasgow steamer "Oak Grove" has also arrived, in ballast, and is loading ore.

"Monthly Violated"

The Rebel Government has protested energetically to Britain, accusing British warships of flagrant violation of the principle of neutrality by interfering between enemy ships, and the "Almirante Cervera." It requests that the British Government will take measures to prevent the repetition of such incidents.

Boat Arrived. Bilbao, April 26. The British steamer "Cumbria" which arrived here this afternoon is the seventh British ship.



An Efficient Guide

AID TO MILLIONS OF PEOPLE IN FOLLOWING HISTORIC CEREMONY

The Official Souvenir Programme of the Coronation of King George VI and Queen Elizabeth is now on sale throughout the world. Its publication was celebrated at a luncheon party over which H.R.H. the Duke of Gloucester presided.

Through its pages it is possible to measure much of the significance of the Coronation; to share, even at this distance across the sea, the emotions of the millions of the times with those nearer to the scene of history in the making.

With dignity and beauty the Programme presents the religious devotions and traditional rites of a ceremony that is over 1,600 years old.

Empire's Good Wishes

London, April 27. The sovereign programme of the Coronation drawn up under the auspices of King George's Jubilee Trust will be available to the public in all parts of the Empire. To order to meet the Empire demand it has been necessary to prepare no fewer than 12 separate editions.

This fact was revealed by the Duke of Gloucester, who as chairman of King George's Jubilee Trust presided at a luncheon today at St. James's Palace to celebrate the publication of the programme. Most of the 150 guests present had received copies of the programme or distribution of the programme.

Special Editions

The Duke of Gloucester pointed out that the sovereign edition had been designed to be distributed in all parts of the Empire on Wednesday. This had been done by special editions prepared for Canada, Australia, New Zealand, India, and the West Indies. While more recently nearly 100,000 copies had been sent to the United States.

The Duke concluded by quoting the programme the two special editions: "If the people of the British Empire are brought into closer and more intimate touch with the Coronation ceremony, on that day, at that hour, when they are all more than ever in the thoughts and prayers of His Majesty, then the Duke of Gloucester's Jubilee Trust will have performed a noble task."

Fewer Sailors

Mr. Malcolm MacDonald, thinking the Duke of Gloucester's remark a little odd, said that the British navy was smaller than it had been in 1801. 


