# TRIP TO BE ON THE MUCH TRAVELLED CONSULAR DOYEN TO LEAVE KEPA

THE doyen of the Nairobi consular corps, Mr. Richardson Tennant, is about to depart for his post in East Africa, but will not depart until the end of his holiday.

Mr. Tennant has been stationed here since July, 1954, but his acquaintance with East Africa goes back to 1920, when he was a member of the local club. He held a local government appointment in a short time, before becoming a liaison officer with the Ethiopian Government.

# WEEKEND SOLDIER LAUNCHED ATTACK AS DAY BROKE

By COLIN GIBSON

FOUR HUNDRED men recently reported back to offices, workshops and farms all over Kenya after attending the Kenya Regiment annual week-end training camp at Naruru. Almost without exception these men reported an attack as good as that which they did in a fortnight earlier.

During these two weeks they experienced the regular soldier's life: back at home and the rough beds, straw-filled pallets and blankets of their camp. They had to get up at 6 am every day and wash and shave with spiced water. They had no mess-boy to make their beds and clear their boots.

For two weeks they have lived as nearly as possible like regular soldiers, with no furla and no reinforcements. Many of the men arrived at the camp with decidedly depressed views about 14 days of "playing soldiers out in the bush for 12 a day, but after a couple of days they were down to the discipline and routine of the camp.

The programme which was the main aim of the week-end training camp was the maintenance of discipline.


### LIGHTER SIDE

## FINER POINTS OF JUDGING VITAL

By ALEC WARD, Chairman, R.A.S.K. Young Farmers' Committee

MEMBERS of the European Young Farmers' Clubs in Nairobi will be at the Royal Show in a few days. Some of these Young Farmers will be acting as stewards for the various sections of the Show. Others will be on duty at the Young Farmers' stand, opposite the main entrance to the Members' Enclosure and stand.

The big event for Young Farmers at the Royal Show is the Saturday morning, when teams of four will show more cows in the Young Farmers' District judging competition.

### ORDER OF MERIT

At 9 a.m. on Saturday the judging of these four and "champion" dairy cows will take place, and at 11 a.m. competitors will be judging the milk cows and British Red Cattle.

These district judging competitions have been a feature of the Young Farmers' movement in all countries in the world. It is vitally important that all farmers should be able to judge the best animal, and so Young Farmers are taught the finer points of judging live stock which, it is hoped, will stand them in good stead if

they have no farms of a reasonable size in life. Competitors are asked to show in order of merit four animals, and when they get to the end of the paddock they have to tell him the order in which they have placed the animals and also give to him a few minutes' their reasons for this order.

Although each club has a team of four entering for these competitions, each competitor is an individual and is not permitted to consult with any other member of the team — although the order for the competitors are awarded on a team basis.

The club will be competing for the cup each competition, and the club that does the best in the four competitions will be awarded the R.A.S.K. District Challenge Cup.


