## THREE INJURED IN RAIL SMASH

### Uganda mail train derailed HEAVY RAIN BELIEVED TO HAVE UNDERRUNNED TRACK

THREE people — European passengers and two African train attendants — were seriously injured when nine coaches of the Uganda Railways mail train left the rails at a curve and careered into a stone wall.

They, together with a woman who was travelling with three children, were taken to hospital at Eldoret, about 20 miles away, where they are recovering satisfactorily. Other travellers and train staff were badly shaken and bruised.

The mail train had left Kampala at about 9 a.m. on Saturday morning, having been delayed by heavy rain. It is believed there has been a lot of rain in the Kipkale area and it is thought possible that the accident was caused by undermining of the track bed.

At first the train ran on the outer line, but when the signal was given to cross the curve, safety was lost and the remaining coaches parted company and left the line. Most of the damage was to the locomotive, which was temporarily out of action at the time.

Rainbow work and communications were made more difficult because the telephone lines between Lwanga and Entebbe were cut.

At 1 p.m. the Post Office issued a direct service to Lwanga and arrangements were immediately made to send relief trains from Entebbe to Lwanga and vice versa.

Entebbe also despatched promptly from Nairobi yesterday and railway headquarters were attempting to arrange transport of stranded passengers to Nairobi by road.

**Rhodesia's use of Beira port discussed**

**THE Southern Rhodesian premier, Sir Godfrey Huggins, arrived in London yesterday for a London meeting for consultations with Commonwealth ministers.**

His Government, the Southern Rhodesian, has agreed to the extension of part facilities of its port at Beira with Portuguese officials.

It is understood that his delegation is remaining in London to attend a Commonwealth Conference on Saturday and continue on Sunday.

**Private talk**

The conference, attended by Southern Rhodesia, South Africa, was held to discuss a proposed new agreement on economic and political co-operation and neighbouring British territories.

It is understood that the talks will go to from Southern Rhodesia through to the port of Beira.

Sir Ronald, the opening speech, said: "We have been discussing the move and the Rhodesians have been asked to work hard."

An immediate inquiry is being carried out by the Government.

The conference will be adjourned until Saturday.

### Pilot made to change course

The pilot of one of three Czech aircraft which crashed in the United States Department in Washington is reported to have been killed in a car accident.

He had been flying a special radio and radar equipment for the taking of free fire for French forces in Indochina.

American Air Force headquarters in Saigon, Vietnam, said the plane had been flying at 10,000 feet when it had to land to change course to a bearing which had led it into the sea.

After a short stay in Saigon, the American Government had the plane repaired and sent it back to the United States.

**Lebanon places ban on Syrian goods**

The Lebanon Government has banned the importation of all Syrian goods into Lebanon, and is maintaining its embargo on the export of all goods, except even if Customs' tax is paid.

**'ATLANTIC NATIONS TALK DEFENCE'**

Members of the 12 Atlantic Pact nations are now discussing in Geneva their five-year defence plan.

The Atlantic Military Supply Board, which includes the chairman of the House of Commons, Mr. H. J. Ward, the British Minister of Supply, and the other 11 members of the Atlantic Defence Council, is to make a stable financial and military and naval supplies and dividing various responsibilities among the Pact nations.

### A Big Opportunity

Copying the practice in Great Britain in which children are invited as special guests to the dress rehearsal of grand military parades, all schoolchildren within motorizing distance of Nairobi were invited to attend the rehearsal of the banding over of the Union Jack at the 3rd King's African Rifles.

To children, dress rehearsals are exciting events and all who see the impressive pageantry of uniforms and military bands are bound to remember a memory of a great day in the history of the Colony... “...not so well... but perhaps those first stirrings of national pride which are the foundation of the further civilisation of a nation.”

For, despite the philosophy of the band leaders who preach against flag-waving, and of the pacifists who deny the right of self-defence, it is those very manifestations which have given to Britain her place in the world.

It is a pity that only a small proportion of the children of the Colonies will be able to watch the full-scale rehearsal of the ceremony which will take place on Thursday and Friday. And those in the up-country towns, like Nairobi, will have to wait for a good many days in the history of the Colony before they can see it.

To those who have seen Nairobi grow from shanty town to city, the banding over of the Union Jack will be of great significance, but in another phase in the development of the Colony.

To those who had made their home in Nairobi when it had already become a city, and to those who have not had the same deep meaning for the symbols of the country as do those who see it for the first time, that while their hearts may for a moment be filled with music and the ceremonial, they will only add another memory to their life.

To the majority of the children, however, this would be their first experience of the ceremony, and it would create a strong impression in these young hearts that the first impressions are the important ones.

They would experience in their initial stirrings of pride in their country a pride which is essentially patriotic, and which breeds and breeds in a Colony which is destined for a great future.

The banding over of the Union Jack on these occasions today when the flags are allowed to fly because as a nation the British Empire is a symbol of peace and courage, of showing off. But when those occasions occur it is the duty of all responsible for organising the ceremonies to ensure that many of the younger members of the younger generation should be in attendance.

The ceremony can never be repeated. On Friday it will be history and the children outside Nairobi will spend this significant occasion in the confines of their class-rooms.

# NO FINALITY IN LEAGUES AS YET

## First six sides in challenging positions

THE second consecutive defeat of Manchester United and a setback for Blackpool were the weekend highlights in the league championship.

With Liverpool's drop to sixth position, it is on goal average only, and they have a game in hand on the leaders.

Manchester's divergent fortunes have been reflected in the last two weeks, with holding Blackpool to a draw, then defeating them 3-0, and then losing the championship race to

Leeds United, who are now in fourth place for the first time since early this season.

Blackpool, who had been in the lead, were unlucky to meet them. They finished the season with ten points.

Everton, who had been in third place, are still very much in the race, but have lost their last two games.

Blackpool, 10th last season, are now in fifth place, and only one point behind the leaders.

### Not out of wood

Count Mahe de la Bourdonnais was born in Paris in 1709 and took his title Count Mahe on the Malabar Coast which he received from the British in 1724. Successful though he was as a naval commander in Bourdonnais is chiefly remembered for his fine work in developing and improving the port of Mauritius—the first port of call known in his day. During his term as Governor he founded the town of Port Louis and was instrumental in establishing the cultivation of sugar cane and cotton. He died in 1753 and Mauritius was subsequently ceded to Britain in 1814. The last of the Kings of Maurice remained the master of the island's colony and Mauritius became one of the major sugar producers of sugar in the British Empire.
