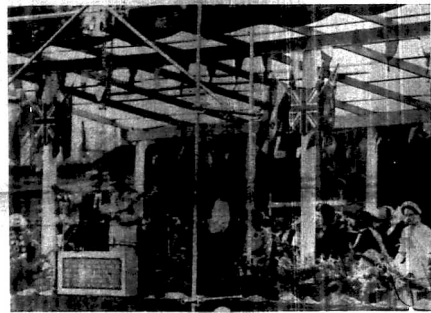
RAIN DID NOT DETER THE LARGE CONGREGATION
