RAIL EXTENSION RECOMMENDED

To link with copper mines
REPORT VISUALISES SPATE
OF DEVELOPMENT

An expenditure of £4 million on the extension of the East African Railway system from Mwanza to Kibaha—a new line which will link up with the Kibaha copper mines—is recommended by the members of the Economic Survey Commission appointed by the Government of Uganda to examine the new railway would pay its own way from the start, says a report of the committee, though its profits at the beginning would be small. This belief is based on calculations of the earnings already available, apart from the prospective ore from Kibaha mines.

The report indicates that a world-famous copper group, Messrs. Phelps Dodge, in partnership with the East African Company of London, will proceed with the development of the Kibaha copper mines and that initial production will be in the region of 100,000 tons of copper-ore each year, which would yield 25,000 tons of metallic copper and coal.

There would be other developments of minerals and agriculture as a result of the railway extension, says the report, which is signed by Messrs. P. J. Latta (chairman), J. T. Sampson and H. M. Gordon.

It says that when the Government had taken the chance of construction by 1941 between Lake Victoria and Albert and the White Nile, the Government had taken the chance of the railway extension to link up with the Kibaha copper mines and other developments of minerals and agriculture as a result of the railway extension, says the report, which is signed by Messrs. P. J. Latta (chairman), J. T. Sampson and H. M. Gordon.

AFRICAN WAGES TO GO UP

Increases to start
from next year

FROM the beginning of 1950 minimum wages for Africans are to rise. Yesterday, Sir Alexander Gurney, Secretary for Africa, announced that the Government in a Cabinet had approved the increase recommended by the Board of African Wages.

In the official notice of the Board, Sir Gurney said that the Government had decided to increase the minimum wage rate for Africans from 10s. 6d. to 11s. 6d. per week, effective from 1st January 1950.

"It is found in the minimum wage rate a certain 'margin' has been set, and cannot be regarded as a 'ceiling' but as a 'floor' which will rise with the cost of living."

"The increase will be the least step which the employer must take."

"There are to increase in the minimum wage rate for Africans from 10s. 6d. to 11s. 6d. per week, effective from 1st January 1950."

MESSAGES TO NEW LIBYAN STATE

Pledge of 1942 fulfilled BRITAIN TO SIGN ALLIANCE IN THE SPRING

The King and Mr. Anthony Eden, Foreign Secretary, have sent messages of congratulation to the King of the newly created Libyan State.

King George's message said: "On this auspicious occasion of the proclamation of Libyan independence, it gives me great pleasure to send to Your Majesty my cordial congratulations and an assurance of my personal welfare and for the prosperity of your country and people."

Mr. Eden said: "I take these words respectfully to convey to your Majesty my sincere congratulations together with my best wishes for your health and happiness. I believe that my personal gift in 1942 has been fulfilled and that I am a free man independent sovereign State named under your Crown. I trust that I shall be able to give your Majesty's goodness and wisdom in the direction of her affairs."

The official communique issued by the Foreign Office announced that the British Residency in Cyrenaica and Tripolitania and the French Residency in the Yemen had formally transferred their status last November to the Libyan Government. It stated that an ultimatum brought into effect the Libyan constitution and the Amir of Cyrenaica (Ismahil) of Cyrenaica, Mohammed Ali el-Mahdi el-Semmani) became King of the new Libya.

President Roosevelt congratulated the Queen of Ethiopia in a broadcast from Washington. He said that the British and French Governments are giving assistance to the Ethiopian economy and British troops are being maintained in certain areas of the country.

THE departure from Southampton of the liner Queen Mary with Mr. Churchill and Mr. Eden on board for New York was postponed yesterday when an anchor jammed. She is now due to sail at noon today.

Mr. Churchill, who will be accompanied by his private physician and the Western Union Ambassador to Britain, will have no deputy Prime Minister during his absence in the United States for Premier with President Truman.

Mr. Churchill would remain responsible for most of his duties while abroad, the statement added that during that time of America the Prime Minister and the Foreign Secretary, Mr. Anthony Eden, would be in constant communication with London and little delegation of duties would be required.

Lord Salisbury will assist at the Foreign Office and Mr. Harry Crookshank (Minister of Health), as a member of the House of Commons, will preside at Cabinet meetings. It is added that the Foreign Secretary expected to return to Britain on January 12 and the Prime Minister about January 20.
