Nine nations attend Moscow conference

Invitation rejected by Western Powers

AS the Communist conference on European security opened yesterday in Moscow, Ministers from 12 Western Powers rejecting a Russian invitation to the talks were delivered to the Soviet Foreign Ministry and to Embassies in European capitals.

Twenty-three European States, with America and China, had been invited, but only seven satellites are taking part with the Soviet Union. China is represented by an observer.

Delegates are to exchange ideas on European security and the steps considered necessary to guarantee that Communists have no ground for East German resignation to ally with Western rearmament and to give warning that the Eastern bloc would form a counterpart to the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation if the London and Paris agreements were ratified.

A Paris report states that Britain, the United States and France, in their replies to the Russian letter of October 23 and November 13, suggested a Four-Power conference only after ratification of the Geneva Treaty and the Agreement on the Austrian State Treaty was also given as a condition.

A summary of the Western reply, issued in Paris, said that they would meet Russia if there were good chances of reaching solutions to the problems of European security. It stated that Russia should explain her attitude towards free European elections, an indispensable step towards reunification of Germany.

EXTRA FUNDS FOR DEVELOPING COLONIES

Government pledge in Royal speech

AID TO E. AFRICA SINCE 1940 TOTALS £5,200,000

The Queen in her speech at the opening of the new session of Parliament yesterday announced that the Government would promote the development of the Colonial Empire. The Colonial Development and Welfare Act are to be prolonged and the funds increased.

According to the annual report of the Colonial Development Council, published yesterday, Britain has spent almost £11,900,000 for colonial development and welfare research since 1940. Approximately £2,300,000 of this has been used to benefit schemes in East Africa.

Her Majesty's speech in the House of Lords was heard by peers and M.P.s. Referring to foreign policy, she said that the Government's aim of strengthening the Western world would provide the basis on which an understanding with Russia might be sought. Full support would be given to the Colombo Plan for economic aid to South and South-East Asia.

A Bill is to be presented to Parliament enabling the Government to carry out its obligations under the Commonwealth trade agreement at the same time increasing to an end the present system of import duties. On home affairs, legislation is to be introduced to improve old age pensions, raise benefits for widows, the sick, unemployed and industrial injuries and improve rules to reduce accidents. The high rate of house building is to be maintained and encouragement will be given to the erection of better schools and technical colleges.

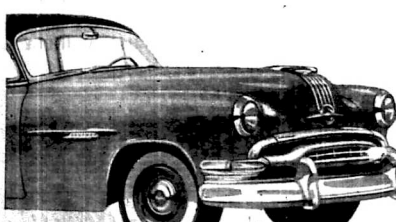

TECHNIQUE OF DEEP DEFENCE

Vital Arsenal triumvirate

If you study Arsenal throughout the past 20 years, you will find they have always had a tall commanding centre-half and two good full-backs. Recall for a moment some of their famous names: at centre-half they've had Herbert Roberts, Leslie Compton and when I saw the Arsenal play Spartak the other evening, the fit, youngster Fotheringham. If the centre-half is consistently well as he did in this match, then he has a good future before him.

At full-back they have had such celebrated pairs as Mann and Huggood, Booth and Smith—both four English internationals. These days they have Walter Barnes, Wain and Len Ward, who have been the best defence which has been the Arsenal's since the war, throughout the years.

It is this strong back-line defence, which has been the Arsenal's strength, that has made a typical Arsenal breakaway so difficult. Now let us have a look at how the Arsenal defence operates in its defence.

The first principle

No 1 principle was always to down the middle should be decided. Thus the centre-half was not allowed to move out to challenge a winger, and he was almost certain to get the ball.

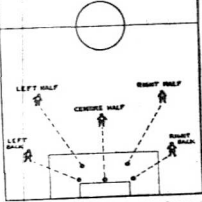

Settlers demand arson be made capital offence

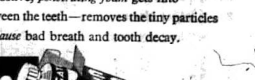

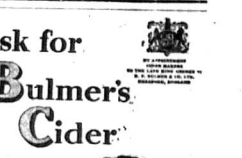

THE DEVELOPMENT OF TELEVISION

TELEVISION is still in its infancy in Holland where there are only about 12,000 sets and broadcasts are made only on three evenings a week. Most of the country lies outside the reliable range of the most important transmitter, situated at Lopik. Thus, many viewers in the north and south of the country can only tune in German and Belgian programmes.

Sweden is seen only by a very few television sets. Apart from the lack of proper, reliable transmitters, the price of the television sets is prohibitive for the vast majority of the Swedish population.

Commercial television in the Netherlands is still in its infancy. The new bill leaves open the possibility of commercial programmes being given some status.

Eurovision
EUROVISION sports events attracted more interest than any recent Euro event. According to a public opinion survey, various reasons are given for the Eurovision's popularity.

Various reasons are given for the Eurovision's popularity in Holland. Chief among them is the fact that Dutch programmes are very popular in other countries.

Large-scale development is expected for countries where television should be seen, whether television is a common television activity.

Television centres here fear that unless the separate radio stations in Switzerland, in the event of a merger, will level playing field with television.

At present the total cost of the television programme is estimated to be about £10 a day. A proportion of television programme normally takes about three days to construct.

Such a programme would cost about £375 an hour, which with an added 10 per cent for supplementary costs, would make a total of about £417 per hour.

There are no plans for Eurovision as a permanent feature in exchange for other countries.

Switzerland
TELEVISION in Switzerland is still only in an experimental stage. There are daily programmes from each centre in German and Zurich, but these are strictly of a test nature.

West Germany
EUROVISION has been in operation several West European countries. It has been a success in West Germany.

More than one-half of the total television sets in West Germany are not licensed but the majority of these "black sets" is not as good as the licensed sets.

Although it is growing in popularity, television is still in its infancy in West Germany.
