ANTI-COLONIALISM ONE OF MAIN AGENDA ITEMS

Pakistan, Burma, Ceylon and India, yesterday agreed a major surprise at their conference at Bogor, near Djakarta, by deciding to invite Communist China to the conference.

Many observers feel that China's inclusion in the conference will automatically exclude all other Afro-Asian countries. They consider that even Pakistan and Ceylon may refuse to attend a conference table with Communism.

The decision on whether to invite Communist China was one of the main topics of the conference, which will probably give prominence to anti-colonialism. The agenda will be considered under three headings.

£400,000,000 arms aid for Asian nations

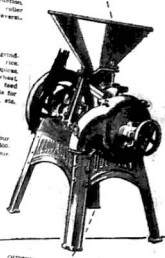

REGULATION OF WAGES AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT, 1951 (No. 1 of 1951)

THE WAGES REGULATIONS (General) Order, 1951

WHEREAS the Wages Advisory Board has submitted a report on the regulation of wages and conditions of employment, 1951 (No. 1 of 1951); and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 4 and 11 B of the said Act, I hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order shall be effective from the 1st day of January, 1952.

2. No person shall, except with the written permission of the labour officer, employ any person in any of the areas specified in the schedule to this Order in any of the occupations specified in the schedule to this Order.

3. If an employer who is not a person specified in the schedule to this Order employs any person in any of the areas specified in the schedule to this Order, he shall be deemed to have employed that person in one of the occupations specified in the schedule to this Order.

4. The minimum wages payable to any person employed in any of the occupations specified in the schedule to this Order shall be as follows:

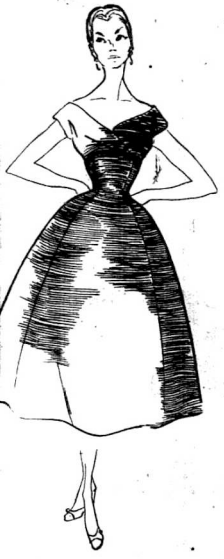
