MR. KRUSHCHEV warned in his first substantive speech that further delay in disarmament "ought with tragic consequences," and that the latest world summit had increased the need for complete disarmament.

The plan, which the Soviet Premier said would create firm guarantees against surprise attack, allows a series of priorities in the Soviet Union's four-year disarmament program rather longer than four years for its implementation.

In messages to Heads of Government, including Mr. Eisenhower, Mr. De Gaulle and President Eisenhower, he announced his latest proposals. Mr. Krushchey said the West was proposing without disarmament, which was nothing but "sabotage" which could not be accepted by a Government concerned for the national interest.

Russians quit research plan

Russia has withdrawn its independent nuclear research programme from the proposed three-nation scientific programme between the United States, Britain and the Soviet Union.

Mr. Krushchey said the Soviet Union had decided to withdraw from the programme in Geneva, that Russia did not intend to continue with the programme on a world-wide level.

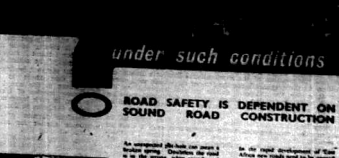

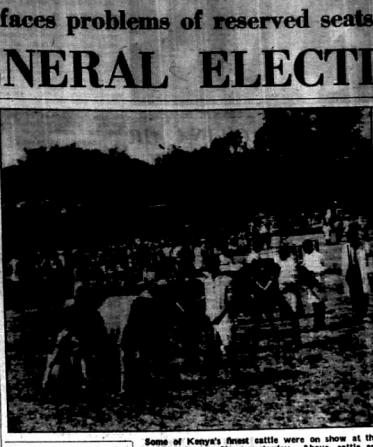
