TWO MORE Mobs clash in streets as new republic born

From KENNETH MEADOWS, MOGADISHU, Friday
Two people were killed and at least 30 people injured during ugly riots in the streets of Mogadishu this afternoon soon after the declaration of Somalia's independence and the forming of the new United Somali Republic.

Steel-helmeted police in the city as tension rose and fresh demonstrations seemed likely at nightfall.

The Opposition groups said to be responsible for the riots are the Greater Somalia League and the Somali National Union.

Only a few days developed outside the legislative Assembly early this morning, met by women supporters demonstrating.

SOMALIS' FIRST PROBLEM

Investment of £4m. a year needed

THE Somali Republic, immediately, will need an estimated £4 million a year to begin reconstruction. Mr. J. K. Johnson, former Labour M.P. for Dudley, said in Harlow.

Mr. Johnson, who attended the independence celebrations in Harlow, said finance was one of the biggest problems facing the new republic, but aid was being given by Britain, Italy and the Common Market.

Referring to disputes over the Had and Ogaden he said the atmosphere for negotiations between the Somalis and Ethiopians would be much more national now that the Somalis were independent.

He said he had been talking to Africans round a table here last February and said, "I am an intermediary," he said, "it will be easier to reach agreement on some way of living together in the disputed areas."

Unique constitution
Mr. Johnson, who acted as spokesman in the House of Commons for the Somalis in the former British Somaliland, said he was not sure if he had seen a constitution drafted in colonial history—it lasted only five days.

Asked if he thought independence would be granted too swiftly he said Somaliland thought it was better to make the move now than later, although it would be an official in the administration would have a little more time.

Pro-British Premier
There were many problems to be solved before plans for a Greater Somalia—which would include the Northern Province, French Somaliland, the Ogaden and the Northern Province of Kenya—was taken any further. Among these were Customs and Excise, living costs, capital investment and the like.

Mr. Johnson said the Somali Prime Minister Mohammed Haji Ibrahim Egal was pro-British and had done a first-class job over the independence negotiation.

16 POLIO CASES
Sixteen cases of poliomyelitis in the vaccinated area, had been reported in Kenya. Killed, non-vaccinated area recorded two cases out of 16 cases 12 were vaccinated.

MICHAELS FARM, a pioneer institution of the Kenya European Welfare Society for the rehabilitation of alcoholics, could now house ten people if there was sufficient household equipment. Mr. W. G. Nicol, the society's president, said at the annual meeting in Nairobi.

He continued: "Our objective is to increase the accommodation so that a further ten residents can be housed, making a total of 20."

But they were particularly short of beds, tables, chairs and farm tools. However, last weekend they launched an appeal for more funds to enable them to complete the project and purchase necessary equipment. They had received 22 1/2 tons.

"The Government has generously agreed to help towards our capital requirements within certain limits by contributing 45 per cent of 55, raised by the society," Mr. Nicol added.

Mr. E. P. Johnson, the treasurer, said in his report that the surplus for the year was a little over £100 and this was after opening and running Michael's Farm for a further six months of the year.

The farm, which has been established in the area of the former Michael's Farm, has a good income and therefore it was most important that the appeal for funds be successful.

IMBABA STRIKES AT RIVALS

Leaders of 'breakaway' group held

MINISTERS of the 'rebel' Government set up in the Kasai Province of the new Congo Republic were arrested in the provincial capital of Lubumbashi on Sunday, it was announced in Leopoldville yesterday.

The breakaway Government was set up by M. Albert Kalonji, a bitter rival of the new Prime Minister of the republic's Central Government, M. Patrice Lumumba.

It was formed last before last Thursday's proclamation of the Congo's independence.

Premier's former ally

M. Kalonji was an ally of M. Lumumba in the Movement National Congolais until last October. He broke with the M.N.C. leader during a local election campaign which led to a number of violent incidents and the arrest of M. Kalonji on charges of treason.

The M.N.C. party then split in two with M. Kalonji leading its more moderate wing. But it was M. Lumumba's faction which won most popular support during the national elections in May.

M. Kalonji has been involved in an intermittent fight with the Lulua people—pastoralists who have resisted Baluba immigration to their territory. His house in Lubumbashi, where there has been street fighting on a number of occasions, is surrounded by barbed wire.

It was also announced in Leopoldville yesterday that 19 Congolese were injured during a Sunday in a new clash on the Kasai between the Congo Government and the breakaway group.

FARMERS' FUTURE SAFE

Need for immigrant races to play part

THERE was a future in Kenya for good farmers, good traders and good industrialists of any race who placed the interests of the country and its economic development as first priority, the Permanent Secretary to the Ministry of Agriculture, Mr. R. J. M. Snyman, told members of the Kenyan Chamber of Commerce.

The major part of the Government's attention must be given to improve the lot of the great mass of the people, he continued. But it was also necessary to ensure that the immigrant co-immigrants — who had been the main source of investment — should continue to play a full part in the economic life of the country and help to maintain that rate of growth which had been such a remarkable feature of the recent history.

Maximum use of the country's natural resources was the object, and the chief resources was the land. Certain handicaps, such as poor standards of husbandry, were being overcome and a great country was expected.

Mr. Snyman pointed out that by far the biggest potential for agricultural development was in Nyanza Province, though people thought greater success were being taking place in Central Province.

'Giant will stir'
That was true just now because the Kikuyu were a tribe who could make a better farmer and grower of cash crops when they could be convinced of it. But I am sure that in the time to come the Kikuyu will stir and develop their vast untapped potential in cash crops such as cotton, coffee, sugar, rice and sisal, and in such crops as maize and groundnuts which will be needed to even out the country's production of food.

Referring to the European Highlands, he said the potential of that area was better than any other in the world. It was a more extensive area of land than any other in the world, and it was better suited to the growing of crops like sisal on a plantation basis.
