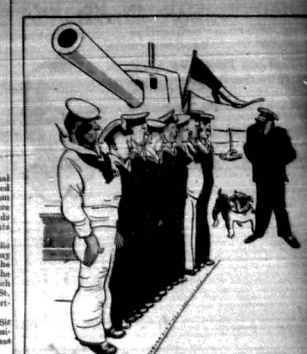

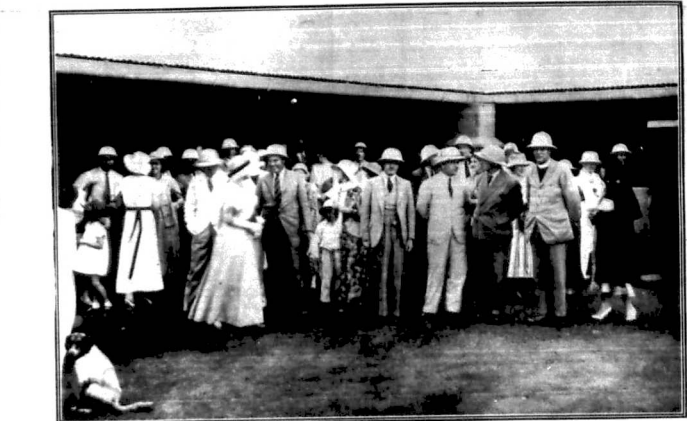

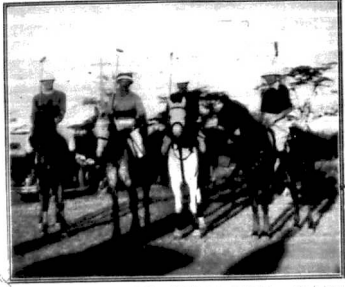

THE WORLD ABOUT TANGANYIKA

Publicity Committee for the N. Province

A NATIONAL GAME PARK?

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT.] Arusha, Jan. 1.

At a meeting held at Arusha recently it was resolved to form a Northern Province Publicity Committee, to be affiliated to the Tanganyika Publicity Exhibition, in Dar es Salaam, and with control of such funds as it may be able to obtain through local subscriptions and donations, and which allocations Government may vote, from time to time, for furthering the following objects: Tourist, game-hunting and photographing safaris; air, road, and rail travel in the Northern Province; residential settlement; mountaineering, fishing etc.

It was agreed that this Committee shall co-ordinate the activities of existing organizations whose aims also include the above features.

The meeting unanimously resolved that the Provincial Commissioner, Northern Province (Capt. F. C. Hallier) should be Chairman of this Committee, and that the Game Warden, Tanganyika Territory (Mr. S. P. Yeats) should be the other official member. It was also resolved that a non-official should be elected to serve as Deputy Chairman and Mr. Frank Anderson, Arusha, was accordingly appointed to this post.

The following Committee was then formed: (General L. Boyd, Mess. C. M. (Van River), Major A. E. Perkins (Moshi); Mr. H. Ullrich (Arusha) and Mr. E. S. Reid (Hon. Secretary).

It was stated at the meeting that a considerable sum had already been paid or promised as donations for publicity purposes in the Northern Province by various firms and individuals.

Friends of Co-operation

Mr. J. Bracker (Imperial Airways, Nairobi) who was present, informed the meeting of the readiness of his firm to co-operate and reciprocate with the Committee in the distribution of its literature in Europe, India and West Australia. Mr. Bracker, Mr. Mattson, correspondent of the Geographical Magazine of America and a public expert engaged by Imperial Airways would co-operate with this Committee on his forthcoming visit to the Northern Province.

Several suggestions were discussed or noted for future action. Two members of the Committee have undertaken to furnish a report on the feasibility of establishing a National Game Park in the Northern Province and the province of East Haven, a landing ground and a route into the Ngongoro Crater, after a survey has been made to those districts in question.

The cost of the organ and its installation, together with necessary alterations to the vestry, will not be short of £350. A certain amount has already been raised, but the bulk has yet to be collected, and an appeal is being circulated, but the task is not an easy one, but the promoters feel that if only every one will give what he or she can, however small it may be, there should be little need for anxiety.

"Full credit would be given to the Government of Kenya for a very genuine attempt to reduce expenditure during the past two years, but that the Government is still necessary, and that increased taxation, whether direct or indirect, will prove no panacea for the position, but will rather stifle the trade and development still further."

"It is an interesting conjecture as to how long the present expenditure in Kenya would be permitted to continue if, as once before, the British taxpayer had to foot the bill of any deficit through the medium of an Imperial Grant in Aid."
