MR. THOMAS AND SIR ALFRED BUTT RESIGN THEIR SEATS

Head of Commons Debate NEED FOR GUARDING JEALOUSLY THE PROBITY OF PUBLIC LIFE.

Mr. J. H. Thomas and Sir Alfred Butt whose conduct was the subject of adverse reference in the report of the Budget Leagues Tribunal have decided to resign from the House of Commons.

Mr. Thomas said he accepted without challenge the findings of the Tribunal but declared that he had never consciously given away any secret Budget information.

The Prime Minister who moved the adoption of the Report emphasized the distinction between the Tribunal and an ordinary court of law and pointed out that the two Ministers had not been found guilty of a criminal act.

Mr. Baldwin and the Leader of the Labour Opposition said tribute to the long and distinguished career of Mr. J. H. Thomas and regretted that it had been brought to an end in such a manner.

UNION TO TAKE OVER THEIR ADMINISTRATION

Premier's Announcement

Cape Town June 12.

A settlement of the long-standing question of the future of the Native Protectorates of Swaziland, Basutoland and Bechuanaland was overshadowed by General Hertzog in the House of Assembly to-day.

The Prime Minister stated that the Union would probably take over the administration of Swaziland in about two years and that the other two Protectorates comparatively soon after that.

The Native Protectorates of South Africa are at present administered by a High Commissioner on behalf of Britain. About a year ago General Hertzog went to London and during his stay there he had frequent conferences with Mr. J. H. Thomas, then Secretary of State for the Dominion, as a result of which it was decided that the administration would be transferred to the Union.

A few months ago the Union Government provided a considerable amount of money in the Budget for the improvement of the native territories. The natives who are opposed to the proposed transfer, originally protested against this provision.

The Union Government gave an undertaking to the British Parliament to transfer would take place without consideration of native views and full consultation with the Imperial Parliament.

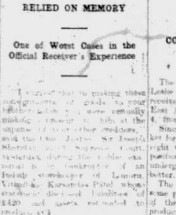

Chamberlain's Policy on Sanctions?

CHANCELLOR'S SPEECH CAUSES SPECULATION

Whitehall Statement

RECOGNITION OF ITALY'S ANNEXATION OF ETHIOPIA NOT INVOLVED

In his observations on sanctions in the course of a speech made on Wednesday evening, Mr. Neville Chamberlain has roused a great deal of speculation as to the likely policy of the British delegation to the meeting of the League Council on June 20.

That the Chancellor's "demarche" had surprised France and Belgium was revealed in an interview in London between the French and Belgian Ambassadors and Sir Robert Vansittart.

From Whitehall it is explained that it is unbecoming to the dignity of a great Power to shelter behind the skirts of South American States if sanctions are to be raised, and that the raising of sanctions would not involve recognition of Italy's annexation of Ethiopia.

"Provisional Reflections"

Highly June 13. The new speech given by the Prime Minister in the House of Commons on Wednesday evening, in which, as the Prime Minister subsequently explained to the House of Commons, he put forward suggestions with regard to the ending of League sanctions, which were "provisional reflections on the Italian-Ethiopian dispute, which had occurred to him," has drawn personal.

Despite Mr. Baldwin's addition, it is felt that the speech is as yet reached no conclusion on the matter discussed by Mr. Chamberlain and Sir Robert Vansittart.

E. AFRICAN CAMPAIGN

Appeal for Documents and Photographs

London, June 13. The Foreign Secretary has issued an appeal to all those who have any documents or photographs which may be of use in the campaign against Italian aggression in Ethiopia.

It was previously announced that the Government had issued a circular asking for contributions to the Ethiopian Relief Fund.

PARIS, June 13. By 9.30 to 172 the Chamber of Deputies today passed the Bill providing for a forty-hour week.

PARIS, June 13. The Renault and Citroen motor factories are reopening on Monday together with most of the other engineering works in the Paris district.

The resumption of work continues in the Province, an example being Bouen, where 8,000 textile workers are returned.

Position in Algiers

Algerian social strikes have commenced in Algiers, of which the most serious is the building strike.

There have been no serious incidents, however, despite attempts to provoke agricultural workers to join the movement.

Later, while there is a general feeling of relief at the settlement of the major strikes in France, new strikes are breaking out in the Provinces and the "strikes" movement has spread to Morocco.

SPANISH STRIKES

Chief of Police Shot Dead in Malaga

MALAGA, June 12. The general strike, coupled with the conflict between the Socialists and Communists, is producing a serious situation.

The Chief of Police was today shot dead in the street, bringing a death toll for the past three days to 12.

The outlook is ominous and serious. The Police covering the mobs to collaborate in arrest of criminals.

Trouble in Belgium

BRUSSELS, June 13. The strike movement is spreading to the steel industry, a general strike of the miners of the Ebroge district is threatened and the transport workers of Antwerp are likely to come out on strike.

EAST COAST CRUISE

British Destroyers at Dar es Salaam

DAR ES SALAAM, June 13. Four British destroyers, the "H.M.S. 'Hona' and H.M.S. 'Friederik' and two other destroyers, are staying for about seven days.

This visit is a purely military one in the course of a cruise of the East African coast.

There will be no special operations during the call.

POLICE OFFICER SHOT IN JERUSALEM

SEVENTEEN PASSENGERS INJURED WHEN BOMB THROWN AT TRAIN

JERUSALEM, June 13. Assistant Police Superintendent Alan Sagar has been admitted to hospital suffering from wounds when shot in the chest.

Constantine Entabi fired at and hit the conductor, the man dying later in hospital. The other assistant died but is being followed up.

It is believed that Assistant Superintendent Sagar's wounds were inflicted by Arab snipers.

Shots were fired during the night at the house of Mr. James Pappas, Deputy Police Commissioner at Nazareth and a bomb was thrown at a passenger train at Kalybia Station on the Haifa-Lod railway. Four Jews were seriously injured and 12 Jews and one Arab were slightly injured.

SEVERE PENALTIES FOR TERRORISM

JERUSALEM, June 13. The death penalty, or life imprisonment may be inflicted for terrorist acts according to a new law.

Firing on troops, bomb throwing and interfering with communications may also be punished in a similar manner.

Collective fines, movable and immovable property may be levied by District Commissioners on the instigation of others, or even upon those who without assistance have a share in the offence.

INCREASE IN INDIAN TRADE

All-India Improvement Recorded

YEAR'S FIGURES

By Drop in Imports from Italy

LONDON, June 13. An all-round increase in Indian trade figures for the year ending March 31 last is shown in a survey by the Overseas Trade Department.

Imports increased by £1,300,000 as compared with the 1935 total, while exports, including re-exports, rose by £6,700,000 to £12,000,000.

Britain's share of the Indian trade shows a decrease of 1.8 per cent, this being almost entirely due to a material reduction in the imports of cotton and piece goods.

Imports from Japan advanced by £700,000. There was also a general improvement in the whole range of German exports.

A fall of £70,000 in imports from Italy is partly attributable to the effect of sanctions and partly to the elimination of Italian competition in respect of cotton.

Imports of raw cotton, woolen and artificial silk textiles rising to the highest level in the post-war period and increasing Japanese competition.

South West Africa and the Union

NO LEGAL OBSTACLE TO INCORPORATION

Present System a Failure

UNANIMOUS CONCLUSIONS OF SPECIAL COMMISSION

CAPE TOWN, June 12. "The present form of government of Mandated South West Africa is a failure and should be abolished. There is no legal obstacle to government of the territory as a province of the Union of South Africa."

These are the unanimous conclusions of the Commission—composed of two judges and an economist—appointed by the South African Government to investigate the incorporation of South West Africa.

INCORPORATION DESIRABLE?

The members of the Commission differed as regards the desirability of incorporation of South West Africa in the Union.

The Chairman of the Commission, Mr. Justice Van Zyl, states that the German section in South West Africa has organised themselves into a solid block under foreign guidance.

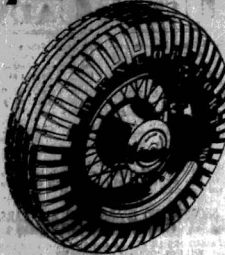

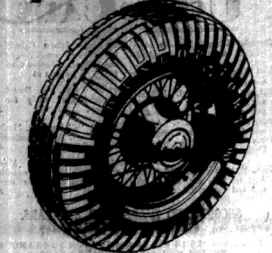
