Spanish Government Troops Land in Majorca

STORY OF SWEEPING ADVANCE DENIED

Rebel Leaders Executed

HEAVY NAVAL BOMBARDMENT OF SAN SEBASTIAN REPORTED

Despite the rumors which the insurgents holding the island of Palma laid down in the coastal waters, to prevent the landing of Government troops, loyal soldiers have landed in force, but it is not certain what followed their landing.

The report, from Madrid, states that the Government troops are carrying all before them and are expected to capture Palma shortly. The other, presumably from Rebel headquarters, states that the forces holding the island for the insurgents, attacked the Loyalists shortly after they had landed and defeated them with heavy loss of life. A British cruiser is standing by.

The bombardment by Rebel warships of San Sebastian is reported to have begun, while from Madrid it is stated that two Rebel battleships, found guilty by court martial of having taken part in the rising at the Montana barracks, were shot at dawn.

NON-INTERVENTION PACT

The non-intervention pact makes further progress, and it is reported that the German reply to France, associating the Boies with the declarations by Britain and France, has been handed to the French ambassador.

A latest message states that Berlin's acceptance is qualified by three conditions, namely that Spain releases the German acceptance obtained at Madrid; that all states with industries manufacturing war materials and aeroplanes bind themselves not to export to Spain; that Germany is to include supplies from private sources, and that the Governments concerned prevent the departure of volunteers to help either side.

Civil Aircraft Movements

Madrid reported that Government forces landed in Majorca and, according to three columns, were met by a number of private aircraft, which were shot down. The fall of Palma is reported shortly.

It is reported that the British cruiser "Albatross" is standing by at Palma for any emergency. Many British have already been withdrawn from Palma.

PUNISHMENT FOR MURDER OF TWO JEWISH NURSES

Jerusalem, August 18.

Another outrage shocked Palestine last night. On this occasion Jaffa was the scene of the crime, in which two Jewish nurses, taking an evening stroll, were shot dead.

The situation in Jaffa and Tel-Aviv, where a Jewish girl was killed and several others injured by a bomb, the day before yesterday, is regarded by the authorities as serious.

The drastic measure has been taken of ordering all the inhabitants of Jaffa to remain in their houses from eight a.m. to-day until five a.m. to-morrow. It is understood that this order not only shows the view taken by the authorities, but is also imposed partly as a community punishment for last night's dastardly murder.
