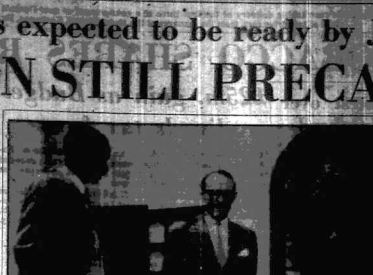

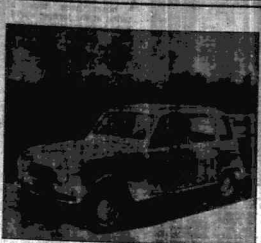

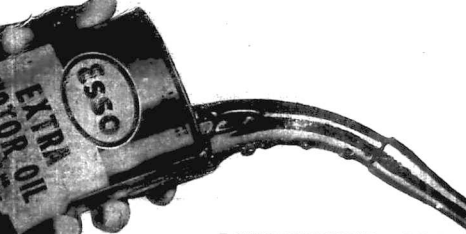

Mr. Focks was re-elected vice-chairman.

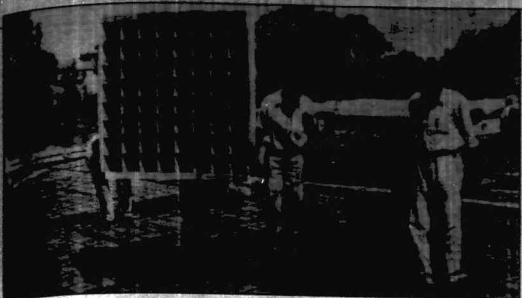
Sound-proof roof for TV block

Police searching for power-saw gang

KENYA suffered its second act of sabotage in ten days yesterday when the country's telecommunications link with Uganda was cut for more than seven hours.

A wrecker gang believed to have been armed with a motor-driven saw, cut through telegraph poles over a stretch of five miles leaving a mass of twisted wire along the main Nairobi-Nakuru road. None of the wire was stolen and none of the wooden poles was missing.

East African Posts and Telecommunications officials told the East African Standard: "This was purely a malicious act of sabotage aimed at disrupting the country's communications."

Whole system affected

He said he could have understood it if the gang had cut down the poles in order to go to the wire — which is worth about £50 a foot — but to cut the wire was touched. "They obviously set out to sabotage the whole system, and succeeded," the spokesman added.

All the sawn poles were cut cleanly and it is almost certain that the saboteurs used a motor-driven saw. One man held the night to have taken down this much damage.

The first poles fell some 300 yds before the main line, cutting the telegraph line between Nairobi and Uganda.

Two tumblers near the Ngori line, about 14 miles from Nairobi, and two others created by the ground five miles further along the line.

After the poles fell, the telegraph engineers and telecommunication were sent out to repair them.

They worked throughout the night to restore the line but seven hours later communications were temporarily restored.

No arrests

All yesterday's workmen were still employed by the telegraph department, but they are being investigated, but so far no arrests have been made.

The other recent case of sabotage in Kenya was when a telegraph line was cut near the coast. It was described as the most serious sabotage in Kenya since the Government took over the telegraph system.
