## WATER AUTHORITY SUGGESTED

ESTABLISHMENT of a national water authority in Kenya was strongly advocated in a paper by Mr. Ivan Langford Roberts, chief hydraulic engineer in Kenya's Ministry of Works of the Kenya Government, to a conference of civil engineers.

Mr. Roberts said the most important advantage to be gained by the creation of such an authority, controlling both water supply and sewerage throughout the country, should quickly become self-financing and should therefore tend to reduce development costs.

The pattern of the authority, which is already functioning over half the country, has been established by the formation of the Nairobi Water Board. The board could well form the nucleus of a national authority.

Mrs. Nyerere said: "My husband says that all those who want to build up a new country should learn how to do it from Israel. His opinion is the opinion of all my people — and that is why we came to Israel."

Mrs. Jamal commented: "We have very little to learn from the highly developed societies of the West, but Israel, a country with problems similar to those of our own continent, has done a great deal of good work in the past few years. It is a country where the people of the poverty of the people of the poverty of the country, great Western countries would not be suitable for us as we do not have the means."

"We women have cows, but they do not give more than the average. Like Victoria, it is not so easy to get the milk out of them. 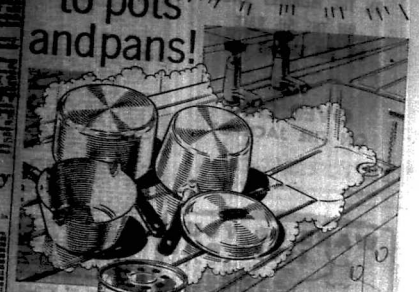

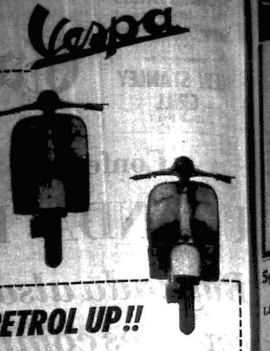
