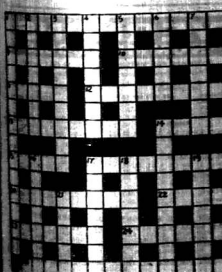

# Kenya's best in prices

## INCREASED LAST YEAR

### HIGHER prices fetched by Kenya coffee last year were very comforting to planters but had unfortunately led the country to new markets.

The Coffee Marketing Board, Mr. G. Shields, told the Kenya Coffee conference in Nairobi yesterday.

The crop rose to 2,565 a ton) had prices too high for these markets and Kenya had virtually lost the foothold it had gained in contracts with Holland and Germany. It had also lost ground in the United States.
