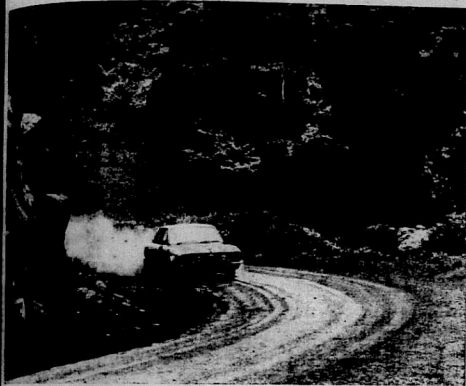

More than an outside chance existed last night that the 16 Ford East African Safari would make history as an international rally by producing no finishers.

It was also obvious that if there was to be a winner it would be one of three Peugeot 404s left in at Dar es Salaam — and a good bet that Shaukuland and Rothwell would achieve the fantastic feat of three successive Safari victories.

Only eight cars survived an ordeal of mud, floods and rain, which had been in the quarter of the day in Nairobi. The leaders were Peter Huith and Gerry Grant, whose Lotus Cortina had lost 485 points. But the Peugeot 404s were not to have undisturbed trouble.

Close behind were the Peugeot 404 Injection of Nowicki and Cliff — and "Magicalster Seven" year, now almost certain to be replaced by lack of finishers by a "Saturated Six" or even a "Wonderful Four".

Nowicki and Cliff had lost 519, and their teammates, Shaukuland and Rothwell, were only four points behind, and approaching their own "star hairy" country of the Kiroka Falls.

One question had been settled before Dar es Salaam: The Peugeot 404s had only to keep going to win the Team Manufacturers' Prize, as the other team was left in.

The Distans, which had given them a tough fight since the latter part of the Southern Leg, had only two cars left, the Ford Lotus Cortina and the Peugeot 404.

The three Peugots, all in the hands of Safari veterans, had been in the background for most of the Northern Leg, but the Peugeot 404s at Dar es Salaam showed the consistency of cars and drivers; only four points separated Nowicki from Shaukuland and Rothwell.

Leading cars had fallen with great regularity since the 21 Northern Leg qualifiers left Nairobi. Soderstrom and Pato's Lotus Cortina sank in the mud at Laidokali. The Triumph 2000 of Haggerty and Lawrence had dropped out after a spell in the lead.

Dataun, out of the team crew, were placing their faith on Joplinger Singh for an outright win. But after being first, second or third for most of the way he ran into difficulties and had extended maximum permitted lites on the Southern Leg, but later started to carry on after repairs.

Joplinger and Saei finished seventh in Dar es Salaam at 11:30 p.m.

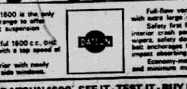

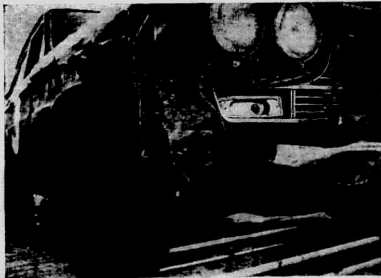

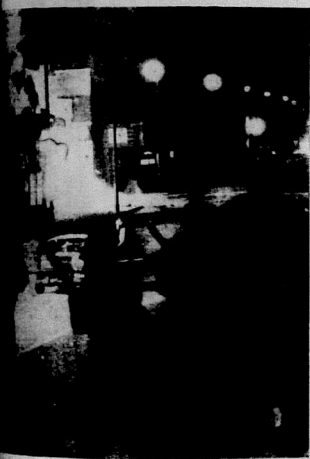
