

# TRADITIONS AND CUSTOMS OF THE BRITISH PARLIAMENT

THE centuries of history which lie behind that democratic institution, the British Parliament, have given it many strange traditions and customs. Some of the ceremonial traditions of the public are the case of the Opening of Parliament by the King at the start of the session—but behind the various proceedings are many rights and privileges not generally known.

With Britain on the verge of another General Election ARTHUR NETLETON, a Fellow of the Royal Geographical Society, contributes a topical article on the centuries of tradition which lie behind many of the customs in the ceremonial life of the British Parliament.



### Dumb show

The first of the dumb shows is the one which is held in the House of Commons. It is a tradition that the Speaker should make a speech at the start of the session, and this is done in a dumb show.

The picture above was taken looking down to the Floor of the House of Commons from one of the galleries. Below is the entrance to the House, and the main part of the picture is the House of Commons itself. The House is a large, ornate building with a high ceiling and wooden paneling. It is a place of great importance in the life of the British Parliament.

### Precautions

SOME precautions against rebellion of the House of Commons have been taken in the past. For instance, a strip of carpet laid across the floor in front of the front benches made it impossible for the Members of Parliament to leave their seats without the permission of the Speaker. This was done to prevent the House from being divided into two camps, one for and one against the Speaker. This was a tradition that was maintained for many years.
