TRANS-NIOZA'S PLANS FOR A NEW CONSTITUTION

Critic says they 'propose partition'

'STANDARD'S SPECIAL COMMENTOR' KAMPALA 'TRANS-NIOZA'S suggestions for a new Constitution for Kenya were criticized by several speakers at a public meeting held in the last of the series of four held in Kitale Sports Club.'

The proposals which have been submitted to the Electoral Commission by the Trans-Nioza Committee, are based on a system of local self-government under which there would be autonomous provincial councils for the White, Indian, African, Mau Mau, and Nioza land units and for 'common opportunity' townships and 'D' areas. The proposals also envisage a central council for the larger areas of the country unalloyed at the moment.
