Most significant events in 1951

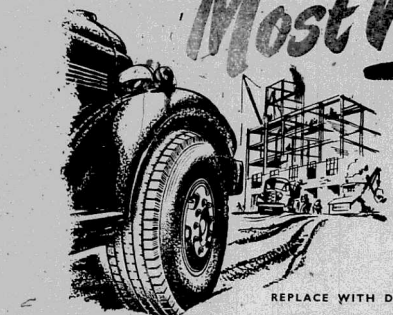

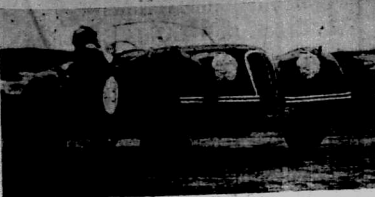

WORLD BANK SENDS OIL MISSION TO ABADAN REFINERY

The World Bank has sent a two-man mission to Tehran to begin studies which will lead to the re-equipping of the Abadan Refinery. The mission will use the facilities of the refinery so that the management will be advised on the practical requirements of operations, and a bank spokesman in Washington.

It was emphasized that the bank would not be providing a loan until it was satisfied that the refinery was in a position to accept a comprehensive re-equipping operation.

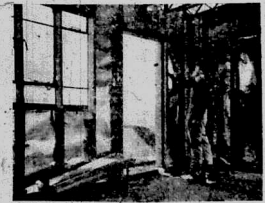

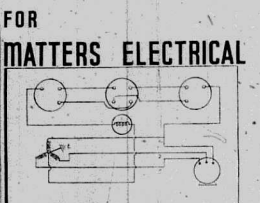

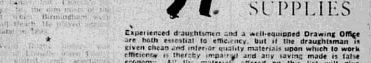
