Tribute to King George

All the nations of the world, disaffair for a day their ideological differences and their suspicions. Paid solemn tribute yesterday to the worth and character of the late King George the Sixth and his Commonwealth, Democrats and Communists, walked together in procession through the ancient streets of London at the funeral of the beloved head of the British Commonwealth and Empire. Some of these foreign dignitaries represented countries with which the Commonwealth was at war during the year when the personal example of King George made so valuable a contribution to the ultimate victory.

But yesterday when death had come to King it comes to every man and woman. They too mourned for their subjects the passing of a man of upright character and high principles of public and private conduct, a man whose short life and brief period of kingship were spent in doing good. King George carried a burden which would have bowed down one who enjoyed perfect health and strength. His courage, his sacrifice, his great spirit are left with us as another example of the superiority of the mind over the body and the triumph of the spirit however weak the body.

As Mr. Churchill said in his moving tribute to one of the most great and great monarchs, King George walked with death and he did not fear death. A friend in these last months so that when the end of his pilgrimage came he was ready and not afraid. It was in keeping with the Christian faith which was the guiding light of his whole life, and from which he drew the strength that enabled him to rise higher than the obstacles, the handicaps and the dangers, and difficulties with which Fate had so plentifully beset him.

The silent crowds through which the cortege passed in London yesterday were the common people. They were soothed with him the nation's finest hour. With them in spirit, swelling their affection, mourning with them, sharing, to their restrained pride in the life that had been lived in their service, were the untold millions of every subject in every one of their homes, their cathedrals, their squares and temples and mosques, throughout the world.

It has been borne upon the great family of Commonwealth and Empire nations during this week of grief that no man's world has a new respect for the Monarch and the Crown and all for which these symbols stand. Never before in history has the Crown been held in such esteem and with such understanding respect among the world's peoples; never before has it been so deeply cherished by those who have inherited it. Now they enjoy its tradition and its leadership. Not at any time—and these are testing times for kings and democratic institutions—has it been so much to a people world-wide as steadily through the darkness.

King George's life and thought and his personal characteristics, his example to all his peoples, his Christian faith and outlook, the serenity of his home life, his wisdom and confidence and understanding, have among the reasons why there is so much affinity with the Commonwealth and Empire nations today. As much kindly thought, so remarkable a delegation of responsibility from all the world to pay their last respects to a man who can and will give thanks for him.







Scheme to aid children of ex-Servicemen


