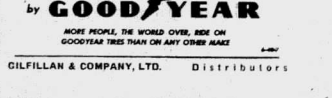

TOUGH VIRUS CAUSES INFANTILE PARALYSIS

RESULTS of recent research into poliomyelitis have been described to the South African Health Congress in Cape Town. Infantile paralysis, said Dr. James Craig, of the Union's most resistant of the known human viruses.
